We hope you all are well, safe and healthy in this challenging time. So, as we were to start practices this past Monday, 7/13/2020 and due to the current advisement from the County of Riverside on 7/9/2020 and Governor Newsom's roll back of the opening of the state due to spikes in the COVID-19 situation we were unable to do so.

Our priority is and will always be the safety of our players, managers, coaches and parents as we move into the Winter 2020 baseball season.

We have completed registration and collected money for this season, teams are in process of being assembled and distributed to the managers. Our permit information, insurance, etc is into the city and ready to go if we are to receive a green light from Riverside County then ultimately The City of Corona.

After discussion with the executive board we are postponing the start of practice to Monday 8/17/2020. If at that time it is determined, we are still unable to safely practice and play games the Winter 2020 baseball season will be cancelled. That date has been chosen after review of the 16 game schedule being able to be completed just prior to the Thanksgiving Holiday

If at that time we must cancel the season all registered players whom we have collected monies from will receive a 100% refund of said money. As we have that date slated on the calendar, our board will be meeting soon to discuss the return process so we may make it public at that time.
