

# League President Responsibilities

- 1) **Appoint a Tournament Director.** A president of the league can be a director but cannot be a manager or coach of a tournament team.
- 2) **Assign someone to keep the book.** This job should be handle by someone that knows the rules. We prefer an adult and not children.
- 3) **Tournament Weather Updates:** Each league and each division should consult with the league president for weather information. Our district covers a very large geographic area so determining the weather becomes an issue. The hosting league must consult with Joe Rigler DA or a District Staff member to determine the postponement of any games and the rescheduling. **Joe Rigler DA, can authorize schedule changes only (to times and/or dates no president as the authority to do this).**
- 4) **Make sure at the end of the game Joe Rigler is called immediately with the score; Joe will need the runs by innings, and any ejections from the game.**
- 5) **Umpires are schedule for the game.** The district prefers 3 umpires per game, 4 will be great. When team's plays at its own site, the district umpire-in-chief Steve Fensch will provide the umpires. Leagues do not have the right to object on the umpires if appointed by the Umpire-in-Chief.
- 6) **League presidents should provide a copy of umpires for the district to use under these circumstances.**
- 7) **All fields are considered neutral.**
