

## 2020 All Season Fundraising Parent Agreement

Each team has the opportunity to fundraise for possible travel to Regionals at the start of the football/cheer season August 1. Each team can raise funds for possible travel assuming the head coach and all team members' parents agree to the following guidelines, no exceptions.

- The HEAA board must approve all fundraising efforts. No team can host a fundraiser without approval.
- All funds generated will be held by the HEAA Treasurer and distributed only if the team advances to regionals or nationals and must pay for travel. The HEAA Treasurer will keep record of how much each team member has generated, this amount will be communicated to the head coach and the coach will be responsible for communicating with the parents.
- All funds will be distributed only to the participating players, if there is no participation in the fundraising effort, that family is not entitled to any funds.
- Coaches without children in the program may participate in the fundraising effort and will be entitled to their share of the proceeds to pay for their travel.
- Any funds used for travel must be used in accordance with the league requirement for team lodging, food, etc. Funds will be used to pay for the players, not the parents.
- Participation in team fundraising is not mandatory; however, any family that participates will get an equal share, regardless of how much money that family raised. If the money fundraised is one lump sum then the money will be split equally among those that participate in the fundraiser. If the money fundraised is per individual (such as Yankee Candle, GFS Pies, Buffalo Wild Wings cards, etc) then the individual will get the money that raised and it will not be pooled.
- If the team does not advance to regionals or nationals, all funds generated will be donated to HEAA for the needs of the league. No funds will be returned or disbursed to individual players that do not advance.
- No funds will roll over to the next year's fundraising effort.
- In connection with fundraising, all teams and its representatives shall not misrepresent HEAA's name and activities in any way.
- If the fundraiser involves the sale of any goods or services, the percentage of the purchase price will be retained by HEAA. The percentage will be based off of sales receipts for goods provided and any additional amounts that HEAA is obligated to pay as fundraising costs.
- Any fundraising efforts done on behalf of individual teams do not constitute fundraising on behalf of the league. Any buyouts or funds raised in connection with league wide fundraisers are not connected to individual teams. It is expected that families still participate in the league wide fundraisers or pay the buyout option.
