

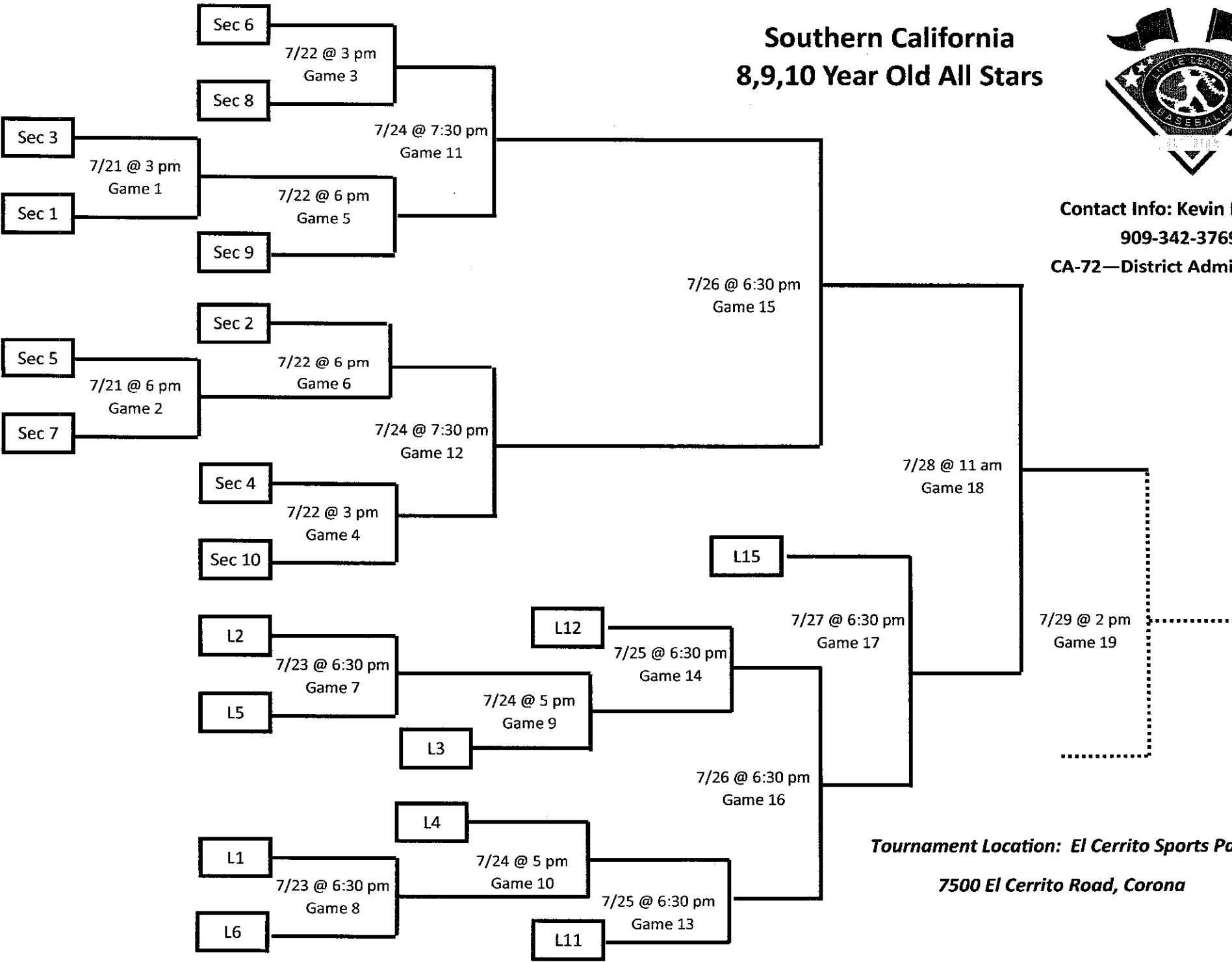

CA DISTRICT 72 ALL STAR GROUND RULES

If possible please bring League Pins to trade with other teams

1. The teams shall arrive at the playing field at least sixty minutes (1 hour) prior to game time and be warmed up and ready to take infield thirty (30) minutes before game time.
2. Tournament affidavits, along with all player documentation MUST be turned into the Tournament Site Director sixty minutes (1 hour) prior to game time.
3. Home team designation will be determined by a coin toss conducted by the Tournament Staff with Team Managers sixty minutes (1 hour) before game time.
4. Three (3) copies of the line up must be given to the Tournament or Site Director 30 minutes before game time. Line up cards will be provided to managers.
5. All equipment will be checked prior to each game by the participating Umpires. Illegal or damaged equipment will be removed. No protest will be considered.
6. The game strategy shall be conducted from the dugout. Conversation from the dugout with spectators may result in the offending player, coach, and manager being removed from the game.
7. There will not be any special seating provided for the team scorekeeper. All changes will be reported from the dugout through the Chief Umpire to the Official Scorekeeper. These changes will then be announced.
8. THE USE OF FOUL LANGUAGE, GESTURES or making of derogatory remarks WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. This shall be cause for immediate removal of the offender from the game.
9. Disruptive behavior by the spectators will not be tolerated and may be cause for removal of the offender from the ballpark by designated Tournament or Site Director's.

11 Additional ground rules pertaining to specific playing field adjustments or expected conduct of team members will be discussed at the opening plate conference with the game umpires.

12. The dress code shall be neat and appropriate for a Little League Representative.

13. Once the game begins, NO PLAYER, COACH, OR MANAGER may leave the dugout away from the playing field without the permission of the Umpires. Stepping outside of the dugout away from the playing field for any reason will constitute leaving the dugout without permission and that person will be prevented from reentering the dugout for the remainder of the game. There will be no tobacco use any kind allowed in or on the field or dugout.

14. Restroom privileges will be permitted providing:

- a. Permission is first obtained from the umpires.
- b. The individual goes directly to and from the rest room without engaging in conversation.

VIOLATION: Offender will be removed from the game

15. No pins or good luck charms may be worn on the uniform or caps of the managers, coaches, or players. No jewelry, inclusive of earrings, may be worn on the field by the manager, coaches or players. Medical alert and religious medals can be worn if they are covered and taped to the body or inside the uniform (out of sight).

16. Cell Phones, PDAs and other electronic devices will be allowed in the dugout for score keeping purposes only. Any use for communication will result in immediate ejection of the offender.

17. Managers, coaches and players are to conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times.
