 - Completed Safety Plan Submission, ONLINE

- Player registration data must be submitted ONLINE req #14
- Please contact District Safety officer (Domenic) for questions and assistance.
- **Must be approved prior to March 13th**

V Misc. Items for Review and explanation:

- Review waivers
 - Download and Use the most current forms, each season. [Found at LLU website under “Forms”]
 - Out of Boundary Player waiver explanation [typed on league letter head with board approval and presidents’ signature], submitted to district with correct form.
 - School Enrollment form [must update when players graduates each year], submit a copy to district (electronically).
 - Reg 2(d) & 4(h) waiver must submit current form, dated 3/8/18 to district for approval
 - Reg V(a) waiver to allow 12-year-olds to play in minors [District approval]
 - Combined Team waivers - **Online only**
 - Interleague waivers - **Online only**
 - Special Games waivers [must submit current form to district for approval]
 - Timely submittal and accurate uploading of players, managers and coach’s registration data. What this could mean to you.
- Change in charter and insurance procedures:
 - Charters due into Headquarters by 12/31/19
 - No certificates will be issued until insurance payments are received
- Explanation of online charter & insurance registration
 - Review Local League Resource Guide – to be mailed to president.
 - Please contact Western Region if you do not receive it.
 - 10 free rule books if insurance documents are postmarked no later than 1/31/2020.
- Managers and Coaches clinic count now due and **Send list of attendees to Rich Sperber.**
- Umpires clinic – District 40 – February 23, 2020 & TBD time and location
- 2020 Season Paperwork due by the January meeting (if you haven’t already submitted it) to the District: **changed & approved constitutions, Budget and By-Laws** (*electronic soft copies only*).
- Deadlines missed are subject to financial penalties for this season.
- Paperwork due to HQ according to regulations.

VI Out of Boundary players (NOTE: The district does not have the authority to allow players who do not reside within your leagues boundaries to participate in your league and this does not allow such participation without a proper approved waiver)

- **Prior to start of each season, the district will identify each player assumed to not reside in your league boundaries.**
- **A listing of players will be sent to each league's president for review.**
 - **The president shall be given 30 days in which to evaluate this list and submit a letter to the district identifying how each player is qualified to play in your league (type of waiver noted on list)**
 - **Once that return letter has been received and reviewed, the district shall notify you of your violations and solutions.**
 - **Item above will be modified if your league has met with the district and worked out a plan to resolve these issues in the future.**
 - **This plan must be in writing and signed by the league president and secretary verifying approval by your board of directors.**
- **Failure to resolve out of boundary players without a waiver will be directed to Little League Western Region office for action.**
- **Failure to abide by written agreement as stated above could disqualify those players from MSM-TOC.**
- **If ineligible players are found on your TOC roster, your team will be disqualified and their previous game forfeited, your team will be removed from tournament play and you will be issued a penalty assessment.**

VII 2020 Rule changes

- Intermediate – Allows managers, coaches and players to enter tournaments in different levels of play.
- Player school tournament exception adjustments further defined.
- Updates to LLB privacy, child protection and trademark use.
