

Oostburg Athletic Association (OAA)
Disciplinary Policy

All: I understand that poor behavior during practices, games, or tournaments may result in lost playing time and expulsion from the team. Anyone who fails to conform to the Oostburg Athletic Association Code of Conduct while attending, coaching, training, officiating or participating in an event sanctioned by the Oostburg Athletic Association will be subject to disciplinary action. Disciplinary action is taken by the Oostburg Athletic Association Board after receipt of formal notification (in writing or conversation with an Oostburg Athletic Association board member --contact information can be found on our website - www.theoaa.org) of the incident, including the date of the incident and the names of the parties involved. Investigation is done by the Oostburg Athletic Association board via separate interviews conducted with the involved parties.

OAA Penalties:

- 1st Offense – One (1) game suspension (parent is banned from sideline)
- 2nd Offense – Four (4) game suspension and/or remainder of season
- 3rd Offense – Dismissal from the team and/or the organization (OAA)

*The OAA retains the right to permanently ban any player, coach, or parent in the event a specific event, series of events, or action warrants such a penalty.

Process:

- Suspensions accumulate over time and are NOT limited to a specific sport or season.
- The four elected board members of the OAA (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer) along with the President of the sport where a violation occurred will vote to determine if an offense warrants a penalty. There will be 5 voting members in all votes to determine if a penalty is warranted and a majority vote is required to administer a penalty.
- Suspensions will be delivered in writing to the affected individuals.

“All” in the Code of Conduct refers to parents, players, coaches, referees, and umpires.
