

BEADLING 1898 ELITE SKILLS TRAINING COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Thank you for signing up for Beadling 1898 Summer Training, we are grateful for your support and participation. Beadling is taking every precaution to ensure player and coach safety while delivering the best program for player growth, development and FUN!

PLAYERS ENTRANCE

- Players will enter one of three door entrances at the far side/ground level of SP
- There will be 6 groups on Mondays and Wednesdays and 7 groups on Fridays
- Players from Groups 1-2 enter door 1, Groups 3-4 enter door 2, Groups 5-7 enter door 3
- Players for the Monday and Wednesday 7:30 session should not approach the entrance door before 7:15 pm
- Parents will park in the front lot and walk their child to their assigned door entrance
- Players will enter and be given a temp check, hand sanitizer and their t-shirt
- Players will be directed to their station and place their water bottle on the sideline
- The head coach for each station will give each player one pinnie to be used for the night

PLAYERS EXIT

- At the end of the session, players in Groups 1-2 will leave through exit door 1 (on the opposite side of the entrance door). Groups 3-4 leave thru exit door 2 and Groups 5-7 thru exit door 3
- Each exit has a different set of stairs leading to the exit door
- Parents will greet their child outside the designated exit door

PARENTS

- Parents will be notified in advance of their child's designated group # and entrance and exit door #'s
- Parents are asked to wear masks at drop off and pick up
- No parent may enter the building
- Parents will park in the SP front lot and escort their child to and from the building
- Parents may remain in their parked car or leave and return for pickup
- The road/path around SP will be blocked. Car traffic is potentially dangerous at night with children walking to and from multiple doors around the building

SP LAYOUT

- All garage and standard doors will be left open to promote better air flow
- Both field curtain dividers will be down to create three distinct field spaces
- There will be one head coach per station with six stations in total
- One assistant coach will support two stations for a total of 3 assistants
- There will be two directors, six coaches and three assistants for a total of eleven staff
- On each of the opening nights - Monday July 13, Friday July 17 and Monday August 3 – there will be an additional two coaches per entrance door conducting temp checks, sanitizer and t-shirt distribution. For all other sessions, the three assistant coaches will be stationed at each entrance door to give temp checks and sanitizer
- On the three opening nights, there will be one coach stationed in the front parking lot to direct parents and players and answer questions and a coach on the upper level outside the exit doors to assist with pickup

EQUIPMENT

- Each child should wear a white shirt and white socks and bring a water bottle labeled with their first name and last initial
- Each child will use only one pinnie given to them at their first station
- Staff will remind players not to touch balls, goals or cones with their hands
- Pinnies will be washed and sanitized after each session
- Equipment will be cleaned before each session
- High fives and any intentional or unintentional touching/grabbing will be discouraged

COACHES

- All coaches will be masked
- Coaches will practice safe distancing, not touching players and staying six feet from players and other coaches as much as possible

IN ADDITION:

- Bathrooms will be open for players and coaches. They will be cleaned and sanitized prior to the evening sessions. There will be sanitizer outside each bathroom and everyone will be encouraged to use it before and after using the bathroom
- There will be signs on each door indicating entrance and exit doors 1-2-3
- Beadling will post our health protocol bullet points on a poster board outside SP
