We hope that you are all safe and healthy.

We wanted to send an update regarding the status of the current season and trainings. We continue to monitor all relevant information and take guidance from our leadership team, board of directors and governing bodies; Pa West, US Club , National League, MDL and US Soccer, as well the CDC and healthcare experts.

The consensus from each of these organizations has been to postpone all training, games and tournaments for the health and safety of the players, their families and the community at large. The initial suspension was through March 29, 2020 and is now April 14 - a date that is being re-evaluated daily.

These are extraordinary times and we are working hard to ensure that we make decisions that are in the best interest of our players, are fair to all our stakeholders and ensure the financial sustainability of our soccer club, a nonprofit 501 C3.

At this time, we are evaluating our fee structure. Beadling has paid for the majority of the spring season, including league registration fees, tournaments and field rentals, all of which are fixed costs. There are significant variables in terms of what the spring season will look like, and we are exploring all options of how to manage it in a fair and appropriate manner. As we learn more information, we will continue to re-evaluate payment and service delivery, and communicate any changes in a timely manner.

Through all the challenges, we remain focused on our mission of developing soccer players while prioritizing their health and safety. We are looking at alternative soccer related activities and will continue to post training videos that are available on our YouTube channel: Beadling SC.
