## Parent & Player Commitment Form

Attention Parents: Before registration will be accepted for your child, the Board of Directors, Officers and Coaching Staff would like for you to be aware of the following information:

Playing midget football requires a major time commitment on the part of the parent(s) as well as the player. It requires:

- 2-2.5 hours per evening, Monday through Friday for the entire month of August. An occasional Saturday practice may also be scheduled.
- When school starts, practice will be 2 to 3 evenings per week for 2 hours per evening. A game is scheduled every Saturday and Sunday through late October. You will be given a complete schedule at the beginning of the season.
- Playoffs/Super Bowls are scheduled for November, if necessary.

Players are required to attend and participate in all practices. If a practice is missed, playing time may be affected. Late Cheerleaders may be excluded from the half-time show for safety and planning purposes.

Please contact the coaches by phone or email if you will be late or absent at any time (as soon as possible). Each coach will provide parents with a home and/or cell phone number when practices begin.

No gum chewing and no food on the field. No jewelry, earrings, necklaces, etc.. Wear your uniform and have proper equipment at all times, you can not participate unless properly equipped (this is for safety reasons).

Each parent is required to work in the concession stand during one game for each child they have playing in the league. This time will be before or after your child's game. NO exceptions.
