

## PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

It is a privilege and not a right to participate in CAA sports programs.

- 1) Place academic achievement as high priority.
- 2) No participant shall act in an un-sportsmanlike manner while on or near any playing field before, during or between games or practices.
- 3) Unsportsmanlike conduct by a participant includes but is not limited to:
  - a. Use of disconcerting acts or words.
  - b. Disrespectfully addressing the game officials
  - c. Showing disgust with game officials' decisions.
  - d. Using profane or insulting language or gestures or baiting or taunting any other
    - i. participants.
  - e. Making any contact, including spitting, with any other player which is deemed
    - i. unnecessary and/or incites roughness.
  - f. Fighting or throwing any punches
- 4) Respect my team-mates, the other team ,the referee and my coaches
- 5) Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- 6) Listen and respond to what my coaches/team parent tells me
- 7) To encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at all times.
- 8) To do the best I can each day, remember that all players have talents and weaknesses the same as I do.
- 9) To treat my coaches, other players and coaches, game officials, other administrators, and fans with respect at all times: regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability, and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- 10) I will exercise self-control and control my temper, resisting the temptation of retaliation.
- 11) To know and respect the rules of my sport and abide by them at all times.
- 12) Show respect and courtesy to officials and coaches by following their instructions and direction.
- 13) Respect the game officials and refrain from addressing them or commenting on their decisions during or after the game.
- 14) Avoiding the use of abusive or profane language, taunting or humiliating remarks, and/or gestures and physical assault upon another player at any time.
- 15) Respect the coaches and players of the opposing team and display sportsmanship at the conclusion of a game and be humble and generous to victory and courteous in defeat.

- 16) Win with character, lose with dignity. Winning is not everything...It is how you play the game.
