Policy: CASA Policy Regarding Tournament Cost Sharing

As passed by the CASA board of directors, the following procedure will be used for purposes of determining player costs related to attending and participating in tournaments.

Recreation and Developmental Teams

Players on recreation or developmental team rosters will not be responsible for paying 'per player' fees (tournament registration fee, coach meal/lodging per diem) associated with their team participation in a sanctioned tournament if that player chooses not to attend the tournament; provided the player / parent / guardian notifies the head coach and/or team manager of their intent to not participate prior to the team making a formal commitment to participate. Fees will be equally divided among all rostered players attending.

Select Teams (Academy, Classic, and Challenge)

Players on select team rosters will be expected to participate in all sanctioned team tournaments and pay the 'per player' fees (tournament registration fee, coach meal/lodging per diem) associated with their team participation. Fees will be equally divided among all rostered players. The only two exceptions to this policy are:

- Players who are injured prior to the team committing (registering) to the tournament and are removed from competition until after the tournament dates. Injured players must notify the team coach / manager by the commitment date to be exempted from paying the fees.
- When a tournament the team will attend is over a set of blackout dates the player / parent / guardian furnished to the team manager or coach prior to the season starting. Select players cannot opt out of State Cup competition because of a blackout date.
