To qualify for the Board of Directors, you must be a member of HLL for a minimum of 1 year and is in good standing. If you are interested in applying by completing an application online. Past applicants are encouraged to reapply.

Membership Meetings

Regular meetings are held the third Monday of each month. Between April & November meetings are held at the Field house. Winter meeting location is to be determined. All parents and adults over 18 years are welcome to attend.

Tryouts & Cuts

There are no Tryouts or Cuts. League rules and By-Laws allow us to carry a maximum of 35 players for Pee Wee and 30 players for Freshmen, JV & Varsity teams.

Coaching Staff

Head coaches must be at least 21 years old and submit an application to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors then will vote on applicants at their regular board meeting. Each head coach then submits a list of assistant coaches. The Board of Directors reviews the list and acts accordingly. We run a Background Check on all our coaches & board members. All coaches must be certified through NAYS.

Any complaints should be referred to your Head Coach after following the 24 hour rule first. If you do not get a satisfactory resolution you should then consult the Commissioner, Coordinator or President. If you are still dissatisfied, you have the right to file a formal complaint in writing to the Board of Directors. Coaches devote a tremendous amount of time and energy to the children and our program. Please give them your support. They deserve your respect and assistance. If you are interested in Coaching please see the Head Coach, Commissioner, Coordinator or any Staff member.

Football Equipment provided by parents

1. Mouth guard - Must attach to the helmet. You can purchase these at the snack stand for \$1 or at any sporting goods store. No Clear mouth guards allowed!
2. Protective Cup
3. All-In-One Football Pants w/Pads
4. Cleats - No metal cleats allowed!
5. Chinstrap- Please wait until after uniform handouts before purchasing as different helmets require different chinstraps.

Practices

Through the month of August, practice runs Monday - Friday from 6pm-8 pm. Attendance is required. Practice sessions are important not only for learning the sport but to physically and mentally prepare the players for the competition of the games ahead. Football is a rugged contact sport and every player needs to be properly conditioned before sustaining any contact with the other players. Poorly conditioned players are an invitation to injury. Cheerleaders must also be properly conditioned before stunting our policy is that all players/cheerleaders must have 10 consecutive hours of conditioning practice before hitting/stunting. They must then have 10 consecutive hours of hitting/stunting practice before playing in a game. HLL's policy is to field the best conditioned teams, equipped with the best equipment possible.

Chronic absenteeism will not be tolerated!!!

Practices are mandatory. If you must miss, a parent must contact your child's coach prior to start of practice.

Please make sure your child has a water bottle.

School

School comes first!!!! Any child who is letting football or cheerleading interfere with school will be released from their HLL obligations.

Parents should confer with the head coach, who will take the appropriate action to ensure that children's grades will improve.

It has been our experience that the confidence generated by playing football and cheerleading has helped scholastic performance.

Care and cleaning of football equipment

HLL has provided the youth football equipment. We have spent a considerable amount of money for it and a great deal of time caring for and maintaining the equipment. The average cost per child for all football equipment dispersed is \$500.00. We expect you to care and maintain the equipment we have entrusted to you so the next child will receive it in the best possible condition.

The following suggestions will help you achieve this:

- 1) Do not use extremely hot water or bleach as it ruins the elasticity and shrinks the uniform.
- 2) Do not mix jerseys and pants with any whites as the colors may run.
- 3) Mild soap or detergent and warm water can be used to wash girdle pads, shoulder pads and the interior of the helmet.
- 4) Do not attempt to remove the helmet pads.
- 5) Air dry all the pads.
- 6) Do not use high heat to dry the uniforms.
- 7) If your uniform / equipment is not turned in, you will be charged \$500.00
- 8) All equipment must be returned on time, cleaned and complete no later than 2 weeks after the season ends or you will be billed the full value of the replacement equipment.

Football Practice

-1st week wear t-shirt, shorts, cleats and helmets

-2nd week-end of season: practice jersey and pants, cleats, equipment.

Cheer Information

Cheer apparel will be set up by HLL, there will be a sizing day after registration and the purchase will be paid for that day, or will be offset by a fundraiser.

When we drop down to 3 days a week - competition practices, only 2 practices can be missed. School activities come first and will not be held against you.

Cheer equipment to be purchased by parents (if we use the same items the following year child does not have to purchase)

- 1) Spanks, these can be purchased from the cheer coordinator (mandatory) Cost \$10
- 2) Cheer sneakers (mandatory) - (approx. \$50-60)
- 3) Crop (mandatory) - (approx. \$25)
- 4) Jacket (mandatory) - (approx. \$92)
- 5) Black Wind Pants – can be purchased at Wal-Mart/Target/etc.
- 6) Clear rain poncho - can be found at the dollar stores or the camping department of Wal-Mart

Practices are mandatory; if you must miss a parent needs to contact your child's coach prior to the start of practice.

Please make sure your child has a water bottle and has appropriate attire for practices:

- T-shirt and shorts (no jean shorts/skorts, no spaghetti strap shirts)
- Cheer sneakers

Cheerleading Notes

- 1) Girls cannot wear any jewelry
- 2) No earring...No taping ears!!
- 3) No nail polish
- 4) Girls must wear cheer sneakers
- 5) Hair must be pulled back off face with Jazz clips/Bobby Pins
- 6) Absolutely No eating messy food in uniforms!
- 7) **No use of cell phones will be permitted, emergency use ONLY!!**

Please do not pierce ears right before or during the season....you will not be able to keep them in for practice or games NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

Cheerleading uniform care - Uniforms can be washed on the gentle cycle and MUST be hung to dry...do not put in dryer.

Parents are responsible to replace any uniform not turned in the condition it was received. A complete uniform costs \$185.00 If your uniform is not turned in you will be charged \$185.00.

Returned Checks

In the event we receive a bad check for any reason you will be assessed a \$40.00 fee which will be due 7 days after receipt of notification. We then have the option of not accepting checks in the future.

REFUNDS: No refunds will be given for participants who quit after 7/27/20 – NO EXPECTATIONS!

Banquet

Each year a dinner is held for the children and their parents to recognize their achievements. Each football player and cheerleader attends for free and receives a yearbook for their participation. To help us defray the cost we will be soliciting ads and you can become a patron for as little as a few dollars. Children must turn in complete uniform before receiving their complimentary ticket!

Games/Competitions

Games are held on Saturday(s) beginning around August 22nd. The cheerleaders will also attend up to 3 competitions. We expect the season to end by middle of November. There are risks and dangers in football and cheerleading and while we strive to keep participants safe, some serious injuries may occur.

Parent Behavior

Please remember that children model their behavior after what they see adults do. Parents at games should not let their emotions show a lack of self-control. Healthy cheering and encouragement really helps the children and their spirits. Any inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and you may be asked to leave and/or removed from HLL for the season.

Please avoid the following:

- Derogatory comments to or harassing of officials and the opposing team.
- Disparaging remarks about our own teams & coaches-Placing undue pressure on your own child. This will take the fun out of the game. **ABSOLUTELY NO ONE IS TO INTERFERE WITH A COACH DURING A GAME OR PRACTICE!** If you feel the need to speak with a coach, please come early before practice or plan to stay later after practice to discuss the matter. All of the coach's attention needs to be on the players during practice for learning purposes and the safety of our participants.

Parent Responsibilities

- 1) Conduct themselves as ladies and gentleman at all practices & games.
- 2) Pick up children promptly from practices and games.
- 3) Lend a hand when needed.
- 4) If a complaint arises see your head coach first.

Enforce equipment use rules

- All HLL equipment is to be used at Hamburg Little Loop games & practices only. Not to be used for play.

Player Responsibilities

- 1) Conduct themselves properly by using good sportsmanship and respect for their fellow players, coaches, staff & opponents.
- 2) Report all injuries to their coaches immediately.
- 3) Take care of and report all equipment problems as soon as detected. If a player demonstrates poor behavior on or off the field he/she may receive a game suspension or be removed from HLL for the season.

Complaint/Grievance Policy

While we do all do our best to satisfy everyone, we know that is not always possible. If you have a complaint we ask that you follow the protocol below:

- 1) The 24 Hour Rule should always be followed. If you are unhappy please wait 24 hours for your nerves to settle before approaching anyone.
- 2) Any complaints should then be referred to your Head Coach. Please speak to the coach privately. Away from children & other parents.
- 3) If you do not get a satisfactory resolution you should then consult the Commissioner, Coordinator or President.
- 4) If you are still dissatisfied you have the right to file a formal complaint in writing to the Board of Directors.

Rain & Cancelled Practices

Yes, we do practice **in the rain!** Please be advised that practices continue no matter what the weather is. Keep in mind that it may be raining where you are, but clear at HLL or vice versa. In case of lightening, we go under cover, and then resume practice after it has been clear for 15 minutes. Depending on the severity of the weather, practice may end early. Please be considerate and do not just drop your child off in inclement weather; stay at practice so you are available if needed. If practice ends early, a HLL staff member must wait with your child until you return.

Volunteer Fee

To receive your volunteer fee back all you need to do is volunteer a total of 8 hours between from the 1st practice to the very last practice or otherwise identified by the BOD. We do not expect you to help during your child(ern)'s game but there is plenty to do if you want to come a little early or stay a little after your child(ern)'s game. You will need to first sign in on volunteer sheet located in the kitchen and have it signed by Nick Geary or John Sciolino. Refunds will be issued every Friday once hours have been completed and the sheet is signed off by either Nick or John.
