

## **The Victors VBC General Info – 2020 ver. 1**

***Program Change: Beginning with the 2018 season, our club did NOT attend the MJVBA State Championships (normally the first weekend in June). In the foreseeable future, our program will end the weekend before Memorial Day Weekend. This decision was made after years of having to put together, last minute teams to participate in the Championships, due to players leaving the program early. Conflicts with the end of the school year and events like graduation parties have convinced us to end early and free up the holiday weekend for families and staff. If players are set on going to the MJVBA State Championships, we will release them to any other club.***

**Forms & payments:** Your medical forms & a copy of your child's birth certificate should be uploaded to the website. If you have a challenge with this, bring them in to a training session and we will assist you. The Training Fee payment schedule is on the website.

**Training sessions:** Training sessions are setup by each Age Group Coordinator, sometimes as group stations and sometimes as individual team sessions by each coach.
