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## Media Disclosure

Please note that if you are a player, cheerleader, parent, coach, or board member of the Manteca Jr Timberwolves Youth Football and Cheer Team, that you and/or your child/children may appear in pictures/video on the Manteca Jr Timberwolves website, social media including Facebook, or printed material.

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## Manteca Jr Timberwolves Code of Conduct

All participants, parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of MJT events, including but not limited to practices, competitions, and banquets, must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times. Any person who is using alcohol, tobacco or non-prescription drugs and/or appears intoxicated at a MJT event, and/or who is flagrantly rude, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuse, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures with an official, coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, must receive a verbal warning and/or be asked to leave a MJT event. The adult's children may also be removed from the event. Any adult who commits one of the above stated offenses a second time, will be banned from any and all MJT events for a period of one year from the date of the second offense, and their children may also be removed from the program(s) for that time period. Any Person who physically assaults an official, coach, volunteer, staff member or participant or threatens grave bodily harm may be banned from any and all MJT events for one year from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from any and all MJT programs for that same period of time. After the ban has expired, if the individual commits another offense of the adult code of conduct, the individual will be permanently banned from any and all MJT events and the individual's children may also be permanently removed from any and all MJT programs.

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## Team Running Cost

All money raised goes directly back to the MJT Team. No coach or board member is compensated for his or her time or money spent. The Manteca Jr Timberwolves must pay for insurance, league fees, equipment, background checks, field use, referees, EMTs, copies and printing, advertising, jerseys, decals, merchandise and trophies, and several other cost during the season. Our projected budget is over \$50,000 for a season!

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## Parent Commitment

Parents/Guardians are responsible to volunteer 4 hours per child this Football/Cheer season. Manteca Jr Timberwolves will provide an assigned date and time for you to perform your volunteer hours. Areas to volunteer during the season are snack bar, chain gang, announcer, Set-up and Clean-up. It will be the parents/guardians responsibilities to find an alternate volunteer if you need to change any dates and times that you are not able to make. All changes will need approved by a MJT board member.

**\*\*Parents/Guardians will have to select there volunteer time slots at the time of sign ups or a opt out fee of s \$50 will be applied to their total.\*\***

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## Practice/Season/Post Schedule

Our regular practice scheduled is every day - Monday through Friday, 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM until our first game. After our first game practice will drop to three days a week Tuesday through Thursday, 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM. Your player/cheerleader should be on time and ready to practice. If you're going to be late or absent from practice your head coach **MUST BE** contacted. To avoid the possible loss of playing time, participants should not miss or be late to any practices.

Each participant must reach the total number of hours before they can progress to the next level of training as well as play in that weeks game. If the participant is out of practice for over an extended amount of time, (even with a doctors note) they may have to re-start their training hours from the beginning. If your child is taken out of practice or game with a doctor's note, we will need to receive an additional doctor's note clearing the participant to resume normal participation.

Practice wear will be at the discretion of the coach. MJT would like to see all participants football/Cheer should be in team colors for all practices and games. All shirts, shorts, pants, socks should be black, white, grey or blue.

### **Valid Participation**

No participants will be allowed on the practice fields unless the following items are completed turned in and participant is paid in full or on a confirmed payment plan. Completed forms include: CVYFC Player/Cheerleader Application Form, Participant/Parent Contract, **ORIGINAL** Birth Certificate, CVYFC Medical Form, and Current Photo.

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### **Participant Cost Information**

Registration Fee is due at the time of signups. If registration fees are not paid at signups, you child is not considered signed up.

### **ALL FEES PAID ARE NONE REFUNDABLE! THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE!!!**

Cheer uniform and warm ups fees are due at the time of first order. Remaining balances are due by the May 29th. Any orders placed after June 1<sup>st</sup>, will have additional cost. The fee for returned checks is \$25. The repayment is due immediately by cash, cashiers check or money order only.

#### **FOOTBALL**

- Football fee is \$235 per player. \$100 registration fee is due at the time of sign-ups.
  - Football Package:
    - Football Uniforms
      - 4 Jerseys: Home Jersey, Away Jersey, Breast Cancer Jersey, and Homecoming/Playoff Jersey. At the MJT discretion, one jersey will be selected to include the players name and will be given to the player at the end of the season.
    - Pants & Socks
      - Game pant, Practice Pant, Blue Socks, Pink Socks
    - Protective Gear
      - Helmet, Pads, Mouth Pieces, Belts
  - Sports Pack fee is \$65.
    - Mandatory Items to be purchased from the team.
      - Practice Jersey - \$15
    - Required Items to play that does not need to be purchased from the team
      - Girdle - \$25
      - Equipment Bag - \$25
- Cleats are required to play and can be purchased at any sporting goods store. Cleats should have molded or screw-in rubber or plastic on the bottom. No metal screw-ins or spikes allowed! All other equipment such as gloves, arm pads, etc. are parent/player optional and are not provided by the team

#### **CHEER**

- Cheer fee is \$555 per cheerleader. \$200 is due at the time of sign-ups. Package include:
