



UNIFORM CLEANING & DRYING INSTRUCTIONS

*Following these instructions will keep your apparel clean and in good shape.
If not cared for properly, your garments could fade, shrink, stiffen and/or crack/wrinkle.*

PRE-TREATING

- Pre-treat heavily soiled garments with solvents **without bleach**
- Soak blood stains in **cold water** before washing

WASHING

- **Turn garments inside** out to preserve ink
- **Wash in cold water** after each use
- **Use oxygen based** laundry booster
- **High water levels** minimize mechanical action on uniforms
- **Remove garments immediately** from machine after washing

DRYING

- **Hang dry** whenever possible!
- If you must use a dryer, choose a **low setting** like damp dry or air dry
- **Do not overload the** dryer as it will cause ink printed uniforms to stick together
- **Do not use high heat** setting as this could cause shrinking, cracking of ink or wrinkling of twill
- **Remove garments immediately** from machine after drying

STORING

- Store in a **dark, cool and dry** area protected from sunlight and fluorescent lighting
