ABOUT US

Idaho Storm Soccer is a Idaho Youth Soccer Association affiliated competitive soccer club in the Treasure Valley Area of Idaho (Boise, Eagle, Meridian, Star and Kuna).

Idaho Storm Soccer is a competitive club that is focused on the development of the each player. We include a strong emphasis on a team-oriented atmosphere. Through our core values, we strive for **CHARACTER, ACCOUNTABILITY, RESPECT and EXCELLENCE** with possession style soccer.

Our C.A.R.E core values are a direct reflection of how we as coaches, parents, volunteers, and players want to compete.

PRACTICES

Practices are typically held two to three nights a week and centrally located in the West Ada school district. Be sure to ask your coach or manager for more information at parent/player orientation.

Practice locations may differ depending on the team and field availability.

COMMITMENT

Players are expected to participate in practices and games. If players cannot make a practice or a game, the team coach must be notified ahead of time. Parents or guardians are expected to volunteer for their player's team. See Volunteer Opportunities for available positions.

INVESTMENT

Each player who has committed to Storm Soccer Club following an invitation will be responsible for costs associated with club dues, soccer gear, uniforms, tournaments, travel and a coach fee only for teams that do not have a volunteer coach.

CLUB DUES:

AGES: 2008 - 2011 \$375

AGES: 2006 - 2007 \$450

AGES: 2005 ONLY \$450 *FULL SEASON

AGES: 2004 - 2005 \$375 *HALF SEASON

AGES: 2002 - 2003 \$425 *HALF SEASON

Upon player commitment a \$100 deposit is required for player registration. Player team registration is located at www.idahostormsc.org. Club dues cover fees associated with player registration, field rental, referee fees, socks, equipment and operations. Payment is asked to be paid in full. Arrangements can be made into three separate installments. All dues associated with the club costs are due no later than September 1st. Club dues do not cover costs associated with tournaments, travel, team building events, coach fee (only for teams that do not have a volunteer coach) and/or additional soccer gear other than socks.

Players (and their parent or guardian) who are committed to Storm Soccer Club are required to attend an all club information meeting scheduled on Tuesday, June 11th from 7- 8 PM (meet with your team and coach(s) afterward). Location: Outdoor Amphitheater – 2901 E. Pine Ave., Meridian.

TOURNAMENTS

Our teams do play competitively and plan on attending tournaments in the fall and spring seasons. The average cost for tournaments can range from \$40-\$60/player depending on the tournament and player age. Please remember these costs are not included in club dues and player participation is expected. For more information please see your Head Coach or Team Manager at parent/player orientation.
