INSTRUCTIONAL LEAGUE

2019 DATES

Aug. 1st	Deadline for team rosters and checks to be turned in
Aug. 17th	Games begin
Aug. 31st	No games - HBBA hosting a tournament this weekend
Sep. 28th	Last game day
Oct. 5th	Rain out make up days if needed

GENERAL NOTES

- 1) The cost is \$70.00 per player/10 player minimum per team. Make one check for the total amount payable to HBBA.
- 2) HBBA will furnish insurance, game scheduling, umpires and game balls, fields and field maintenance.
- 3) Each team will be responsible to obtain its own uniforms and equipment.

TEAM SELECTION

There will be no draft held to select players. Coaches and parents are responsible for forming their own team. HBBA will assist only in maintaining a list of the names of Henderson players who wish to play and coaches who wish to form a team. It is recommended that parents unable to find a team for their child begin their own team.

TEAM STRUCTURE

- 1) Players may only play in the league this fall that they will be eligible to play in next spring. No older players may be held back, regardless of experience level. The age cutoff date is April 30th.
- 2) All teams will be required to have a minimum of 10 players on the roster.

GENERAL RULES

- 1) Dixie League Baseball rules and local league options will be followed including pitch counts.
- 2) No foul language or taunting of an opposing team or player in any manner will be allowed.
- 3) Teams will play 2 games each on Saturdays.
- 4) Each team will provide a scorebook. The Home team book will be considered the official book. The Visitors will provide a person to keep the scoreboard.
- 5) Each team will be responsible for cleaning out their dugout after their games. Please urge your players and spectators to keep the ball park as clean as possible.

TBALL LEAGUE 6U - Hit From Tee

(born between 05/01 - 04/30, currently 4 & 5 year olds)

- 1) Games will be 6 innings long or 1 hour long, whichever comes first, with drop dead time limit. No innings will begin after time has expired - no exceptions. If the home team is ahead or is unable to catch up when time has expired, they will not take their last bat.
- 2) Each team will be required to play every player a minimum of 2 defensive innings per game, unless a team only plays 3 defensive innings due to time limitations. You may play with 10 defensive players in the field, provided that 4 players are back in regular outfield depth positions.
- 3) Each team will bat all players present (through the lineup). A **5 run** inning cap will be observed through all innings. Players will receive 3 attempts off the Tee.
- 4) Each team must have 10 batters present. A team may play with as few as 8 batters and automatic outs will be registered for one position not batted up to and including the 9th batting position.

PEANUT LEAGUE 8U - Coach Pitch

(born between 05/01 - 04/30, currently 6 & 7 year olds)

- 1) Games will be 6 innings long or 1:15 min hour long, whichever comes first, with drop dead time limit. No innings will begin after time has expired - no exceptions. If the home team is ahead or is unable to catch up when time has expired, they will not take their last bat.
- 2) Each team will be required to play every player a minimum of 2 defensive innings per game, unless a team only plays 3 defensive innings due to time limitations. You may play with 10 defensive players in the field, provided that 4 players are back in regular outfield depth positions.
- 3) Each team will bat all players present (through the lineup). A **5 run** inning cap will be observed through the 4th inning. Starting in the 5th inning there is not a cap on runs.
- 4) Each team must have 10 batters present. A team may play with as few as 8 batters and automatic outs will be registered for one position not batted up to and including the 9th batting position.

TEXAS LEAGUE 10U - Kid Pitch

(born between 05/01 - 04/30, currently 8 & 9 year olds)

*****THIS IS A CLOSED BASE LEAGUE*****

- 1) Games will be 6 innings long or 1 hour and 30 minutes long, whichever comes first, with drop dead time limit. No innings will begin after time has expired - no exceptions. If the home team is ahead or is unable to catch up when time has expired, they will not take their last bat.
- 2) Each team will be required to play every player a minimum of 2 defensive innings per game, unless a team only plays 3 defensive innings due to time limitations.
- 3) Each team will bat all players present (through the lineup). A **7 run** inning cap will be observed through the 4th inning. Starting in the 5th inning there is not a cap on runs.
- 4) Each team must have 10 batters present. A team may play with as few as 8 batters and automatic outs will be registered for one position not batted up to and including the 9th batting position.
- 5) Pitchers will only be allowed to pitch 2 innings per game with a max of 75 pitches per day.
- 6) The pitcher's rubber will be 46 feet.
- 7) Bases will be 60 feet.

LITTLE LEAGUE 12U

(born between 05/01 – 04/30, currently 10 & 11 year olds)

*****THIS IS AN OPEN BASE LEAGUE*****

- 1) Games will be 6 innings long or 1 hour and 30 minutes long, whichever comes first, with drop dead time limit. No innings will begin after time has expired - no exceptions. If the home team is ahead or is unable to catch up when time has expired, they will not take their last bat.
- 2) Each team will be required to play every player a minimum of 2 defensive innings per game, unless a team only plays 3 defensive innings due to time limitations.
- 3) Each team will bat all players present (through the lineup). A **7 run** inning cap will be observed through the 4th inning. Starting in the 5th inning there is not a cap on runs.
- 4) Each team must have 9 batters present. A team may play with as few as 8 batters and automatic outs will be registered for each position not batted up to and including the 9th batting position.
- 5) Pitchers will only be allowed to pitch 2 innings per game with a max of 85 pitches per day.
- 6) The pitcher's rubber will be 50 feet.
- 7) Bases will be 70 feet.

PONY LEAGUE 14U - Dixie Boys

(born between 05/01 – 04/30, currently 12 & 13 year olds)

*****THIS IS AN OPEN BASE LEAGUE*****

- 1) Games will be 6 innings long or 1 hour and 45 minutes long, whichever comes first, with drop dead time limit. No innings will begin after time has expired - no exceptions. If the home team is ahead or is unable to catch up when time has expired, they will not take their last bat.
- 2) Each team will be required to play every player a minimum of 2 defensive innings per game, unless a team only plays 3 defensive innings due to time limitations.
- 3) Each team will bat all players present (through the lineup). There is not a cap on runs per inning.
- 4) Each team must have 9 batters present. A team may play with as few as 8 batters and automatic outs will be registered for each position not batted up to and including the 9th batting position.
- 5) Pitchers will only be allowed to pitch 2 innings per game with a max of 95 pitches per day.
- 6) The pitcher's rubber will be 54 feet.
- 7) Bases will be 80 feet.

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PARENTAL AUTHORIZATION AND MEDICAL RELEASE

I, parent or guardian of the child whose name is listed on the same line with my signature below, hereby give my approval of the child's participation in any and all of the activities; I do further hereby release, absolve, indemnify and hold harmless the league (Henderson Boys Baseball Association) and the organizers, sponsors, and the supervisors, any or all of them. In case of injury to my child, I hereby waive all claims against the organizers, the sponsors or any of the supervisors appointed by them. I likewise release from responsibility any person transporting my child to or from the activities. I will furnish a birth certificate of the above named child *upon request* of league officials.

I realize that a portion of the registration fee paid for my child goes toward insurance coverage in case of injury to the child while participating in games hosted by the Henderson Boys Baseball Association. Deductibles will be the responsibility of the parents or guardians.

I grant permission for league officials or their representatives to secure medical treatment for my child in case of injury during a league activity or while the child is going to or coming from a league activity.

I grant permission for qualified hospital personnel or nurses or medical doctors or any combination of the above to treat the child or take any measures they deem necessary to the best interests of the child's health when the child suffers any type of injury or health problem during league activities or while coming to or leaving such activities. This applies to activities outside of Henderson as well as inside Henderson.
