- The 2018 Pine Bush Little League season has begun. Please remember that the league is run by volunteers. It is expected that all guardians participate in one way or another. Please ask about field work, umpiring, score keeping or team helper. **HOWEVER, YOU MUST BE ON THE APPROVED VOLUNTEER LIST.** Ask if your team needs a **SCORE KEEPER, PITCH COUNTER, OR TEAM PARENT.** In order to receive a work bond refund a person **MUST** be an approved volunteer. This includes score keepers, pitch counters, etc.
- It is expected that guardians accompany players to practice and games. **Players injured with no guardian present may be sent to ORMC via ambulance, at the guardian's expense. Please also be aware that the EMT's will make the determination if a player needs to be airlifted to Westchester Medical Center due to an injury, at the guardian's expense.** Make sure the manager has cell-phone numbers or a way to contact you in an emergency. It is important that a guardian be at the park to pick up players at the end of the game.
- Managers, Coaches, Umpires, Field Workers and League Officials are all volunteers who work year round to provide a safe and productive Little League Program for your children. You are all invited to volunteer. It is expected that spectators will be proactive and positive at all times. **Negative comments, arguing with umpires and managers and "bad mouthing" any player or adult is unacceptable. Spectators exhibiting poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the field area. It is also expected that guardians be respectful of the manager and coach. They are in charge.** They volunteered and have put in the time. You are more than welcome to volunteer to manage or coach next season.
- The Senior, Major and Minor A Divisions of Little League Baseball are competitive, with standings and playoff games. Minor B and T-Ball Divisions are instructional, with no standings being kept and no playoffs.
- All-Star teams are competitive and inter-league. All information regarding the All-Star selections are confidential. Players on All-Star teams must commit for the entire All-Star season and minimal playing times as stated in the Tournament rules will be adhered to. Players must not expect to "start" every game or play more than the minimum time required by Little League Baseball tournament rules.
- Members are eligible to vote on PBLL policy only after attending (4) monthly meetings the previous season. (September – June.)
- Only uniforms issued by the PBLL are to be worn during games, with NO variations! Players arriving late due to school games may participate wearing a school baseball/softball uniform. The PBLL strongly encourages ALL late arriving "school" players to wear their PBLL issued uniforms.
