Dear Parents, Coaches, Family and Friends,

As we are all well aware, the world is facing an unprecedented time in history with the ongoing spread of COVID-19 globally and closer to home. In our ongoing response to the situation and aligning with our local school districts, **CPYL will be suspending all operations and maintaining a closed facility status through April 5, 2020.** We believe this is in the best interest of our players, parents, siblings, coaches, volunteers and all visitors whose health and safety will always be our top priority. The Board of Directors continues to closely monitor the situation, heeding recommendations from federal, state and local authorities, and are in regular communication with representatives from the City of Cedar Park and other area youth leagues. We plan to make decisions on the rest of the season on a week-by-week basis starting on April 2 (in alignment with LISD) to confirm either resumption of the season, or extension of suspension. In the event an ongoing suspension is deemed necessary, we will communicate with you regarding the impact to the remaining season and Centex All-Stars.

As a reminder, during this period CPYL facilities are fully closed to all persons regardless of purpose or number of individuals, to include games, practices, use of batting cages, and any ad hoc use of CPYL owned facilities. Additionally, teams/coaches are expected to refrain from organizing any off-site events including practices. If any parents are informed of practices taking place, please contact your age group Commissioner immediately and make them aware of the situation. This is for the safety of each of you and the greater public.

Please remember to follow best practices and guidelines set forth by our authorities as we collectively navigate this global situation. Take care of yourself, and those you care for.
