



Volunteer Assistant Coach

DESCRIPTION

Assistant Coaches report to the Head Coach. As needed, an assistant coach may be delegated the role of head coach on a temporary basis for a particular game or practice. Assistant coaches are responsible for assisting the head coach in the instruction, motivation, and development of their assigned team. You will be considered a role model for young athletes assigned to your team. Sportsmanship, fair play, and full participation are all mandatory. All volunteers must pass a criminal background check. Assistant Coaches must be 18 or over and may be male or female.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Assist the head coach in practices and on game days.
Partial list of examples: Warm ups, backing up catcher, coaching first or third, helping to run drills, etc.
2. Assist the Head Coach in developing and facilitating appropriate practice plans.
3. Ensure safety of players while in dugout and monitor the comings & goings of players during games.
4. Work with Head Coach to ensure specialized positions receive appropriate coaching and practice.
5. Provide a safe and fun environment for all players.
6. Encourage parent involvement.
7. Learn and follow league rules, policies, and procedures.
