DESCRIPTION

We're looking for coaches with high energy, exceptional communication skills, and the ability to build team spirit. The head coach is the leader of the team and has ultimate accountability for all team operations. Primary duties include running 1-2 practices per week, skill development, player position rotation, team line-up creations, and coaching all games. You will be considered a role model for young athletes assigned to your team. Sportsmanship, fair play, and full participation are all mandatory. For the safety of all players, all coaches must pass a criminal background check. Head Coaches must be 21 or over and may be male or female.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Teach young athletes the fundamentals of the sport.
2. Work with assistant coaches and team managers to coach players at games and practices throughout the entire season.
3. Provide a safe and fun environment for all players.
4. Encourage parent involvement.
5. Learn and follow league rules, policies, and procedures.
6. Attend league coaches meetings, clinics, and functions.
7. Assume responsibility for equipment that has been provided by the league.
8. Inform players and parents about practices, cancellations, etc.
9. Communicating back to the league; e.g. scores, standings, player evaluations.
