

How to become an AHSAA Soccer Official for 2021 North Alabama Soccer Officials Association

1. Register with AHSAA (Alabama High School Athletic Association)

- Register through **Dragonfly**: <https://www.dragonflymax.com>
Cost = Depends on if you registered last year (\$43.83 or \$74.92)
- Registration Link: <https://www.dragonflymax.com>
- Scroll down and select "OFFICIALS"
- Select the huge blue "LOGIN" in the middle of the page
- Either "Log In" if you have an account or "Sign Up for Free" if you don't
- As you register you will select AHSAA and then SC702 North Alabama Soccer as the Association ID
- Following instructions to register AND background check

2. TAKE TEST

- There is a section to take the AHSAA Certification Test. Highly suggested to NOT take test until you have updated book

3. OBTAINING YOUR 2021 AHSAA RULES BOOK:

Andy Dye and I have the 2021 NFHS Soccer Rule books and we are ready to get them to you. You have 3 options to get your books.

1. Tim will be at Merrimack Soccer Park (Grass Fields) on Saturday, January 16th from 10am to Noon for a drive by pick-up. He will be parked between fields 5 and 8 in a grey Nissan Maxima. 1 book per registered referee. Please wear a mask.

2. Andy Dye will have books at his antique store - 810 Antiques - 810 Bank St NE, Decatur AL 35601. He will be available during his normal business hours from 10am to 5pm Monday thru Saturday. Please wear a mask.

3. Tim Barron will also have books at his State Farm Agency - 151 Hughes Road, Ste A , Madison, AL 35758 - Monday thru Friday from 9am to 5pm. Please wear a mask.

If these options do not work please email me or Andy to try and make other arrangements.

4. SET YOUR BLOCKS (Download the DragonflyMax App)

- Season kicks off in 3 weeks (Feb 4th) and Andy will start assigning soon
- You **MUST** use the DragonflyMax app to set your blocks
- There are tabs for ONE TIME BLOCK and RECURRING BLOCK It is pretty intuitive
- Set a recurring block if you are unavailable the same time each work day (ie 8am to 4pm every day etc etc)
- Remember if you are doing HASL and/or USSF Youth then you **MUST** maintain your blocks on both systems Dragonfly and GameOfficials (a real pain I know)
- If you are assigned a game in either system you must block that time in the other system (yes I know, still a pain but that is why we make the big bucks)

5. Attend NASOA Referee Training Clinic (Mandatory for new officials)
