



Boating Safety Course's (2020)

Boating Safety Classes will be offered by the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office. This course is classroom instruction only. The class covers how to operate a watercraft (including Personal Watercraft) safely and in accordance to the Michigan Laws. Anyone born after Dec. 31, 1978 must have a Boater Safety Certificate to legally operate a Personal Watercraft. Anyone born after July 1, 1996 must have a Boater Safety Certificate to operate a boat. Upon the successful completion of the course, a Boating Safety Certificate will be issued. Anyone under 12yrs must be accompanied by an adult.

Classes will be held at the Holland Twp Fire Station (131 Riley St, Holland)
Class size limited to 30 students
