Rules for Behavior and Conduct at the ballpark

Please Read to your Teams

1. No trips to the snack bar while your team are playing a game.
2. Only sunflower seeds, gum, water, and/or sports drinks are allowed in the dugout. No sodas, glass, or any other food are allowed. Gum must be kept in Player's mouth at all times and not to be discarded on the dugout floor.
3. Uniforms must be worn in a neat manner; shirts tucked in, pants pulled up, and cap worn correctly (bill facing forward). That goes for all levels, Single A through Majors.
4. In foul weather any additional layers (turtle neck, sweatshirt, etc) must be worn under the uniform. Of course, pitchers may NOT wear white long sleeve undershirts.
5. Helmets must stay on the player's head until they return to the dugout
6. At the end of the game, make sure the dugout is cleaned up and all trash disposed of in trashcans.
7. Managers: All line-ups and changes need to be promptly communicated to the scorekeeper. It is imperative that all communication with the scorekeepers be restricted to line-ups and changes only. Any questions regarding players pitching eligibility, etc. needs to be directed to your division's player agent.
