## Executive Board Meeting Notes

1. Roll Call – Present include Alisa Trovato, Jason Oglesby, Katherine Scott, Tim Marks, Paul Mallo, Gary Gudino
2. Public Comments - None
3. Old Business
  - a. Review Minutes from June 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting – Minutes were reviewed by all and approved by Jason Oglesby and Tim Marks
  - b. Registration Numbers
    - i. Currently we have 613 registered players – down from 729 prior to COVID-19. Had about 40-50 new registrants since June 1<sup>st</sup> and announcement of season occurring in July and August
  - c. Season Start Dates
    - i. SWI
      1. Pony/Bronco
      2. Girls Juniors (12U)
        - a. SWI season beginning week of July 13<sup>th</sup> and running through the end of August. Pony will play at SAC 5. Bronco will play at Kolb. Juniors will play at both SAC and Worthbrook West
      3. House Dates
        - a. July 10-August 30
          - i. Dates were pushed back to ensure parents enough time to plan for games and for uniforms to be passed out
  - d. Phase 4 Guidelines
    - i. Sent out and approved by executive board. Sent out to all VPs to share with parents. League provided hand sanitizer.
  - e. Work to Be Done
    - i. Painting of dugouts – still needs to be done
      1. Won't be done until fall due to games begin played now
    - ii. Windscreens
      1. Still waiting on quotes
    - iii. Signage
      1. Still waiting on quotes
    - iv. Plumbing
      1. All plumbing at Kolb is finally fixed with no leaks
4. New Business
  - a. White Sox Camp
    - i. 31 total registrants (down from the 48 originally thought they could have because of COVID-19). League will receive \$620 from White Sox which will be mailed to PO Box. Discussions were had with Michael Huff about how the camp went (we were the first camp and they love our complex; camp went wonderfully) and about possible future ideas to incorporate the White Sox more.
  - b. Raising Canes
    - i. Providing 600 achievement awards in addition to a \$1500 sponsorship and banners

- ii. They also want to do a Eat and Earn with the league in early august. Will blast date to league with information once we have it.
    - c. Park District Fields
      - i. Issues were occurring with overgrown fields at the school fields. D123 is helping park district to make infields playable and should all be set by next week
    - d. SAC/Kolb Schedule
      - i. Jack is working on it. Want it out to VPs by Thursday to make schedules. All game schedules need to be approved by Tim/Sharron, Alisa, and Jack before sending to parents. Need to get schedules out to parents by Friday to give them 1 week notice
    - e. Uniform
      - i. Pick Up Date
        - 1. Should be delivered on Thursday so do a pick up date Friday and Monday. Managers will need to pick up uniforms
      - ii. Pants Exchange
        - 1. Most likely later next week to ensure all uniforms are distributed. Possible second date the following week
    - f. Equipment Pass Out
      - i. Tim and Sharron are handling each sides equipment pass out. Only divisions with bags are petite, juniors, 16U, mustang, bronco, and pony. All other divisions receiving 2 boxes of balls, hand sanitizer, and pixie/pinto are receiving score books.
    - g. Concession Stands
      - i. We will be opening the stand at Kolb and the big stand at SAC. All food/beverages are prepackaged so workers are not opening anything or touching any food (no hotdogs, pizza, popcorn, walking tacos, etc.). Stands will be open for tournament games this weekend. Workers are required to wear a mask and gloves. Mike Canvin is having plexiglass installed at the stands. Chalk lines (SAC) and spray paint (Kolb) will be put down in order to ensure social distancing while waiting in line to order.
      - ii. The Maids will be cleaning the concession stands in addition to the Kolb bathrooms. They were given the option to leave cards in the bathrooms and will be given the option to leave cards at the concession stands.
    - h. SAC Lease
      - i. Going to be meeting with Joe McCurdy in the middle to late July. Want this lease put to bed. Discussed max amount we are willing to pay so Alisa can have a number to talk over with Joe. Willing to combine but Alisa will make sure fields are safe and updated for our league too. Want to make 2 payments to high school (one in January/February and one in August) for total payment owed. Discussed how SAC 4 & 5 need more dirt and will look into doing that next year.
    - i. Kolb Building
      - i. Building is in need of a lot of repairs. Need to start to think of fundraising ideas. Want a contractor to come in to let us know if the building is salvageable or if we need to knock it down and start over. Ideas for starting over include a steel building or smaller building.
