

TOBACCO PRODUCTS BAN

AT BOSTON PLAYING FIELDS

Dear Permit Holder/Applicant,

You are hereby notified that effective April 1, 2016:

- ALL “**tobacco products**” and “**smokeless tobacco**” are hereby banned in ALL City of Boston “**event sites**” used for professional, collegiate, high school, and amateur events, including open spaces, enclosed structures, and stadium parking lots.
- Persons or entities having the authority to manage and control an event site for professional, collegiate, high school or organized amateur sporting events shall have primary responsibility for maintaining compliance with this ordinance.
- Any person found to be in violation of this ordinance may be fined two hundred fifty (\$250.00) per offense.

Definitions for purposes of this Ordinance:

Tobacco product:

Shall mean any product containing, made or derived from tobacco or nicotine that is intended for human consumption, whether smoked, heated, chewed, absorbed, dissolved, inhaled, snorted, sniffed or ingested by any other means, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, little cigars, pipe tobacco, smokeless tobacco; and

Any electronic device that delivers nicotine or other substances to the person inhaling from the device, including but not limited to an electronic cigarette, cigar, pipe or hookah.

Smokeless Tobacco:

Shall mean any product that contains cut, ground, powdered, or leaf tobacco and is intended to be placed in the oral or nasal cavity, including, but not limited to, snuff, chewing tobacco, dipping tobacco, dissolvable tobacco products and snus.

Event Sites:

Shall mean the entire physical area in which such sporting events occur. The event site shall include all open, semi-open and enclosed spaces and structures, including, but not limited to, playing fields, dugouts, bullpens, training rooms, locker rooms, team bench areas, spectator seating areas, pedestrian walkways, bathrooms, dining areas, vendor areas offices, recreational areas and stadium parking lots.
