

## Parkway Little League All-Star Selection Process

1. PLL will develop a Fact Sheet on the expectations and commitment level required to be an All-Star. Majors Managers will provide parents/players on their team with this information and any necessary follow up.
2. The Majors General Manager will email all Majors Managers a list of all eligible All-Stars by May 15<sup>th</sup>.
3. The All-Star Selection process is conducted on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> week of June annually. **The meeting date for 2019 is Tuesday May 28<sup>th</sup>.**
4. Each team is allowed a maximum of (2) two managers/coaches in the room during the selection process.
5. On the night of selection each of the three district eligible All-Star teams will be chosen separately beginning with the Williamsport 12u Tournament team, then the 11u tournament team, and lastly with the 10u tournament team.
6. For each of the three teams the Managers officially nominate all deserving all-stars in the eligible age group (in order of best to worst team record) and discuss player qualifications.
7. Managers vote for top 11 players and votes are kept anonymous by General Manager.
8. Any player receiving 80% of the vote (8 of 10 team votes) or more are All-Stars.
9. The General Manager will announce all elected all-stars, but not the vote totals for all All-Stars.
10. Managers have another chance to discuss their proposed all stars (in order of team record).
11. Managers again vote for the number of players equal to the number of roster spots remaining (up to 11). Any player receiving 70% or more of vote are again selected as All-Stars.
12. The General Manager will announce all elected all-stars, but not the vote totals for all All-Stars.
13. Managers will continue the process in 10, 11 & 12 until no player is elected on 70% of the ballots.
14. At this time, Managers have one last chance to discuss their proposed All-Stars. A final vote is then conducted and All-Stars are elected in order of total vote count.
15. The General Manager will announce all elected all-stars, but not the vote totals for all All-Stars.
16. If there is a tie for the 11th spot. Players involved in the tie are voted amongst managers for the 11th spot. The remaining vote getters list will remain with the General Manager in case an alternate needs to be selected.
17. Manager selects the 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and/or 14<sup>th</sup> players at their discretion. By PLL rule, 12<sup>th</sup> player must be selected. Manager of all-star team has the option of taking a 13<sup>th</sup> player or 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> players at their discretion. These picks will be entirely the manager's choice to best serve the need of the baseball team.
18. Manager's picks must be submitted to the Majors GM before the next round of voting is started or the all-star selection process ends (which ever comes first).
