

Parkway Little League Fan Guide

Summer 2020 Season

Updated: July 6, 2020

Due to Covid-19 and social distancing guidelines put in place by the City and State governments. Parkway Little League has implemented some changes for the upcoming season.

Some of the changes you will see it complex in 2020:

- Limited and staggered games at the complex this summer so there is less activity in the fan areas (games are 5:30, 6:00 and 7:45 Monday through Friday, no games at McDonough Field).
- More space at the Complex this season for social distancing including more bleacher options, areas to bring your own chair and a new picnic area for concession dining that is spaced according to social distancing guidelines.
- Reduction in the number of parking spaces which are available during games.
- Separate ORDER and PICKUP windows at the concession stand.
- Hand Sanitizers installed at select spots at the Complex (please bring your own as well!)

As we try to provide a safe environment for the kids to play baseball this Summer, Parkway LL is recommending the following for all our **fans/family/neighbors**:

- Please do not come to the complex if you are showing any signs of being sick including elevated temperature or other flu-like symptoms
- All spectators should follow best social distancing practices — stay six feet away from individuals outside their household.
- We are encouraging the wearing of masks in all areas where it is not possible to social distance
- We are encouraging all those in a high-risk category to stay home when possible or be very diligent about practicing social distancing at the Complex.
- Spectators should bring their own seating or portable chairs when possible. We are encouraging use of personal chairs, blankets (on the hill) or other means of watching games that allows fans to spread out. Tip for more at-risk spectators: The sidewalk along Baker Street has also served as a viewing spot in years past and will allow people to stay distanced.
- We are asking families to consider carpooling or other options (such as walking or biking) to limit the number of vehicles at the Complex each day.
- We are not allowing kids to enter the Scorers Boxes at any of the fields, these will be reserved for an assigned scoreboard operator.
- We are asking that families limit the use of the bathroom facilities as much as possible. These will be cleaned and sanitized daily, but limiting their use will help keep them clean.
- We encourage families to bring hand sanitizer to the Complex and quantities of hand sanitizer have been placed around the complex.

- Foul balls landing outside the field of play should be retrieved by participating players, coaches, and umpires. No spectators should retrieve the ball.
