Player

1. Report to practices and games on time ready to play.
2. Always make sure you have all of your equipment and full uniform.
3. Let your coaches know in advance if you will miss any practices and/or games.
4. Always display and show good sportsmanship.
5. Show respect for other teams, your own teammates, all coaches, parents, and officials.
6. Never argue with officials.
7. Refrain from using profanity.
8. Zero tolerance for tobacco, drugs or alcohol.
9. Remember that you represent this organization whenever you are wearing anything that says Lakes Athletics; not just at games and practices.
10. You are responsible for participating in any league sponsored fundraisers.

Parent

1. Remain in the spectator areas during games.
2. Don't advise the coach on how to coach.
3. Encourage your child's accomplishments. Don't always point out the negative.
4. Do not coach your child from the stands.
5. Always be aware of your comments. You never know whose parents and/or relatives may be around.
6. Never make derogatory comments to coaches, officials, scorekeepers, volunteers, or players of either team.
7. Help your child meet the responsibilities to the team. Ensure that your child is at practices and games prepared and on time.
8. Always make sure your child's coach knows in advance if they will miss a practice or game.
9. Never use tobacco or drink alcohol at contests. Never attend a contest intoxicated.
10. Cheer for your child's team.
11. Show interest, enthusiasm, and support for your child.
12. Be in control of your emotions.
13. Help when asked by coaches or officials.
14. Thank coaches, officials and all others that help make these events possible.
15. Concerns should be addressed to your child's coach. You then may address the board with a written explanation. LCB Director information can be found at (Lakesareabaseball.com)
16. Always allow 24hrs to expire before confronting a coaches about concerns (unless they are health related)
17. All team meetings must have the coach's approval. Under no circumstances is a meeting to be called where the coach is unaware.
18. No artificial noisemakers of any kind shall be allowed in the stands or dugouts. This includes, but is not limited to, air horns, thunder sticks, bells and the like.
19. A \$25 volunteer deposit per family is required; this will be reimbursed if and only if that family volunteers the minimum 2 hours toward the LCB tournament.
