DETERMINING STANDINGS

Standings are to be determined based ONLY on a teams Wins and Losses. Ties will not count toward standings as there are NO TIES in MLB.

Tie Breakers

- When two teams are tied for a place, the tie will be broken as follows:
 - 1) Head TO Head record
 - a) Comparing who won the most games looking only at the times the two teams played each other
 - 2) Least Runs Allowed in all games played
 - a) Total all runs allowed in every game the teams have played
 - b) Team with the lowest number of runs allowed will determine placing
 - 3) Most NET Runs (runs scored minus runs allowed)
 - a) Total all runs scored and runs allowed in every game the teams have played
 - b) Subtract total number of runs allowed from total number of runs scored
 - c) Team with the most NET runs will determine placing

- If more than two teams are tied for a place, the ties will be broken as follows:
 - 1) Least Runs Allowed in all games played
 - a) Total all runs allowed in every game the teams have played
 - b) Team with the lowest number of runs allowed will determine placing
 - 2) Most NET Runs (runs scored minus runs allowed)
 - a) Total all runs scored and runs allowed in every game the teams have played
 - b) Subtract total number of runs allowed from total number of runs scored
 - c) Team with the most NET runs will determine placing
