

PPWL Allstar Selection Process

The PPWL Board of Directors has created a tryout process for purposes of assembling highly competitive Allstar teams, as explained below:

Eligibility -

Players choosing to participate in tryouts must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a registered player in the current Spring season at PPWL
2. Have no outstanding balance(s) on their account
3. Be willing to attend each Allstar tryout date as set forth by the Board of Directors if requested
4. Must have participated in at least half of the games played during the current Spring season
5. Agree to participate in the mandatory fundraiser/buyout for the Allstar season as set forth by the Board of Directors
6. Agree to attend each Allstar tournament (expected duration - each weekend during June and/or July and August)
7. Agree to abide by PCOC and sign the Allstar Participation Agreement should the player be selected for Allstars

Tryouts -

On a date to be determined by the Board of Directors, approximately MID-SEASON each Spring of the playing year, an open tryout will be held for players wishing to participate in Summer Allstars. No player will be eligible for Allstars without attending at least ONE Allstar tryout date.

All Managers and Coaches will be invited to attend the tryouts.

An Allstar Committee, comprised of members of the Board of Directors and selected Managers from the current Spring Season, will award each player points during their tryout as follows:

Hitting	1	10
Running	1	10
Fielding	1	10
Catching	1	10
Throwing	1	10
Pitching	1	10
Attitude	1	10

Players will have the opportunity to achieve a maximum score of 70 points. The players with the highest number of points will be invited to attend the second round of tryouts.

Second round of tryouts will be invitation based only and will be held on a date to be determined by the Board of Directors. All Managers and Coaches will be invited to attend. Players will be awarded points as in the first round of tryouts.

The top 12 to 15 players based on total points in their respective division will be selected for the Allstar team.

There will be **no automatic freezes** to the Allstar team. Every player must tryout and be scored, ranking high enough to advance to the final team(s).

Number of teams -

The number of Allstar teams per division will be dependent upon the number of players ranking high enough to be awarded a spot on the Allstars. If there are enough players ranking highly enough to form more than one competitive team, the Board may elect to form additional teams.

Coaching staff -

Coaches placing FIRST in their division at the conclusion of the Spring season will be offered the opportunity to Manage the Allstar team. If they choose to accept the position they will pick their remaining coaching staff. Coaches who have been removed from the field of play during the Spring season for behavioral issues will be ineligible to participate in Allstars as part of the coaching staff.
