**Treasurers Report**

Capital Account: \$16,420 (haven't touched – just interest)

Operating Account: \$70,261.61

- Trying to figure out the expenses – have been in the role for 6 months
- This time a couple of years ago, there was \$40k in operating account; accounting has improved
- Followed up with insurance – could be quarterly
- Filed 9-90 – can post it on the website for transparency
- Adam – money for non-profits that we may be eligible for?
  - John – Payroll protection plan is for payroll only- we don't have anyone on payroll
  - There are other grant opportunities out there
    - Sprint?
- Loan forgiven as long as we adhere to provisions of Act.
  - Forgive up to \$10k – cost for facilities?
  - For expenses of 8 weeks

**John Cimino**

- District 12 conference call – no definitive plan or direction for this season at this time.
- Maybe into June and July?
  - Social distancing and gatherings will need to be considered
  - Consider playing spring season into fall?
  - Questions – Rec season and no All-star? Or Single elimination for Districts?
  - All clear for Sept 1
    - If we move to Fall Ball – will work around soccer, travel ball, football, etc.
- Uniforms – still have a 2-3 weeks lag time to order
  - Will forego coaches shirts to save money
- If we were to start the season, need to consider:
  - Children who don't have helmets and bats, we will need to supply them
  - Children can't share equipment
  - Will need sanitizer wipes

- Will need to have a bat and helmet
- Will need to follow CDC guidelines
- Fan wear is in
  - Will need to figure out how to get it to families
  - Jamie rec'd emails from parents questioning about same. We should get info out on how to do it.
  - Can get fan wear at Nottingham Fire House on a certain date and time
- Incident at NLL – young lady who was on back porch studying – saw gentleman with jeans and long sleeve t-shirt and doing in appropriate actions
  - PD called and asked for surveillance cameras
    - NLL assisted police by providing surveillance footage
    - Confirmation of our need secure surveillance to maintain safety on premises
  - Jamie s/w Bob – could look toward future where more than just B Montague is accountable for the cameras – from a security perspective
    - Considering the need for remote access to surveillance

#### **Adam Reymann**

- Roof - no work because all non-essential construction is on hold at this time
- Ironworkers will rebuild the small cage for no cost of labor, materials only
  - Can get administrators of Union to get electrical done
  - Could possibly do it in the fall
- Next week all burnt out lightbulbs will be replaced

#### **Adam Bendas**

- Suggested NLL consider an alternative to refunds if the season is canceled
- Maybe roll it into next season? Fall season?
  - If no refund is requested, it can qualify as a donation – tax deductible

#### **Jamie Leder**

- No further requests for refunds
  - It's been positive – people know what's going on – pandemic
  - Social media posts have been a positive component of our position at NLL
- Need to keep the lawn mowed
