Treasurers Report

Capital Account: \$16,415.22

John Cimino

- Bathrooms (Covid19), cleaning \$30/day, 7 days a week following end of games
- Picture Day – Eric Bonifazi is heading – 3 potential dates – Head shot and then imposed into team photo.
- There will be no Jerry Salzano Camp.
 - Instead, there will be a pick-up Sandlot Camp.
 - 9-12 year olds
 - Up to 30 kids
 - \$30/day
 - Will follow Health guidelines for social distancing
- Practices during the season will only be done away from NLL premises. When doing so, NLL Guidelines for Social Distancing and Health precautions will need to be followed
 - This includes signing out the temp kit and returning it to the cage
- Angel Boden has agreed to head the OD duties
- John Sangillo will no longer be using facility for his hitting program/lessons
 - Moved to A's facility
 - This causes a deficit in income for the league that we will need to consider going forward.
- Requests for refunds are now being pursued
 - Options: Full refund, donation to the league, roll over to the following season
- No Player Pool
 - If players are needed, will pull from opposing team into outfield for defense
- As a Board, we need to set an example of best practices for social distancing while enjoying NLL. This is for the best interest of the health of the kids and their families.
 - Wear a mask when around those you have not quarantined

- Coaches should wear a mask
- Show leadership
- No field crew on duty this season
 - Coaches and parents will need to set up fields (rake, striping, batters box, etc.)
 - Home team sets up, Away team cleans up
 - OD enforces duties

Adam Bendas

- Idea for still using the dugout while social distancing
 - Mark dug outs so chairs can be positioned 6 ft apart as well as from the dog out bench.
 - Dug out can still be used, but while social distancing
 - Dug out sample was set up in Reed Dug out. Reviewed by Board and approved.
 - OD to take out chairs from dug out at the end of the night

Auxiliary

- Final decision for league play is a limited kitchen
 - Candy side only
 - Drinks, candy, ice cream, pretzels, occasional hot dogs
 - Food Trucks will be on site multiple days offering a hot food option
 - Ex: D&D Catering, Pizza, Twisted Steaks
 - Trucks will donate back to the league for space
 - Trucks will set up approx.. 4pm and stay until 8 or 9 pm depending
- Sneeze guard and plastic shield will be used at candy window
