BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Peotone Park District that:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A NO SMOKING POLICY

shall be, and is hereby, approved as follows:

WHEREAS, the Peotone Park District intends to adopt a policy concerning smoking in Peotone Park District facilities and on Peotone Park District Grounds.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOTONE PARK DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All recitals set forth above are hereby fully incorporated in this Ordinance as if set forth in their entirety in this Paragraph 1.
2. The Board of Commissioners of the Peotone Park District approves and adopts the attached Peotone Park District No Smoking Policy.
3. This Ordinance shall take full effect immediately upon its passage. All previous ordinances, resolutions, motions and orders of the Peotone Park District Board of Commissioners in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
4. If any portion of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid or non-binding, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.



PEOTONE PARK DISTRICT NO SMOKING POLICY

To curb youth/ teen smoking and the use of cigarettes and smoking in general, and to adhere to the Smoke Free Illinois Act, the Peotone Park District, in conjunction with the Will County Health Department and Peotone High School Teens Against Drugs, has developed a No **Smoking Policy** for all parks and recreation areas within the Peotone Park District Boundaries. All visitors to the parks and recreation areas should abide by this policy, with the understanding that those who do not will be asked to leave the park and/or be subject to a fine of \$100 for the first offense, and \$250 for the second offense per the Smoke Free Illinois Act. Signage will be placed at no smoking areas and all visitors to the park and recreation areas should be aware of these designated no smoking areas. Refer to the Smoke Free Illinois Act (410 ILCS 82/1) for specifics on the Act and penalties.

NO SMOKING AREAS

There will be no smoking in ALL public indoor enclosed areas (room, kitchen, bathroom) of the Main Building, even during a private party/ building rental. Any who smoke inside the public indoor areas of the Main Building will be prohibited from using/ renting the Main Building and Park Pavilions in the future.

There will be no smoking within 15 feet of all external doors, windows, and ventilation intakes of the Main Building in accordance with the Smoke Free Illinois Act.

There will be no smoking in or within 15 feet of the external doors, windows, or ventilation intakes of the bathroom building on the Main Park grounds in accordance with the Smoke Free Illinois Act.

There will be no smoking in or within 15 feet of ALL portable restrooms placed on Park Grounds.

There will be no smoking in or within 20 feet of ALL designated playground areas.

There will be no smoking under and within 20 feet of ALL pavilions while children are present and during ALL youth/ junior high school/ high school programs, camps, and events.

There will be no smoking in ALL dugouts of ALL baseball/ softball fields.

There will be no smoking within 20 feet of ALL baseball/ softball/ soccer fields during youth/ junior high school/ high school games, practices, camps, and events.

There will be no smoking on ALL bleachers and picnic tables of ALL baseball/ softball/ soccer fields during youth/ junior high school/ high school games, practices, camps, and events.

There will be no smoking on the Park walking/ biking/ running path during ALL walking/ biking/ running events.

SMOKING AREAS

There are no designated smoking areas on the Peotone Park District property. Visitors are expected to adhere to the "No Smoking Areas" described above when visiting the park and recreation areas. Those who choose to smoke while on the Peotone Park District property should use designated trash receptacles to dispose of all smoking materials. When disposing of smoking materials ensure the material is no longer burning. Do not dispose of smoking materials in the pond, bushes, or any landscaping on the Park grounds.
