



PARENT AND PLAYER AGREEMENT

Parents/guardians of a Sandhurst Soccer Club (SSC) player(s) agree to:

1. Pay all SSC fees in full when due and accept that late fees will be assessed when payments are not made by their due date.
2. Accept that registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
3. Read and accept the Club's rules, policies, and procedures and all financial terms and conditions. The club's policies and procedures can be found at <https://tshq.bluesombrero.com/Default.aspx?tabid=2696508>.
4. SSC not releasing a player who has an outstanding monetary balance with the Club or his/her team. If a player is not released, he/she would not be allowed to play with another club affiliated with MYSA until that player's debt is settled with SSC and SSC releases him/her.
5. Commit to not recruit SSC players to transfer to another soccer organization.
6. Accept that any parent or player found recruiting SSC players may be suspended for up to one year and may be further disciplined by the Executive Committee. In instances where a parent is directly involved, and has more than one player in the Club, the suspension may be extended to include all other family members.
7. Notify the Head Coach and/or the Club Director if a member of another club's coaching staff or representative approaches them for purposes of recruiting their player son or daughter.
8. Support their player as well as other Club players in a positive manner.
9. Allow the coaches to manage the players and refrain from offering additional instruction during games or practices.
10. Avoid criticizing players, teammates, coaches, the Club, or opponents in public.
11. Respect the need for a cooling off period immediately after games and not attempt to offer critiques to coaches until sufficient time has passed. All critiques will be approached in an adult, positive way and must not occur in front of youth players.
12. Ensure that their player refrain from using foul language, alcohol, drugs or nicotine.
13. Treat all players, opponents, parents, officials, and coaches with courtesy, respect, and good sportsmanship.
14. Accept that the Club reserves the right to move players between its teams.
15. Provide transportation to their player son/daughter to and from all soccer events and ensure their player son/daughter is prompt in arrival and departure.
16. Ensure that the player is properly equipped for participation in all soccer activities.
17. Support SSC fundraising activities in ways that help make the activities a success.
18. The use of any photos, films, videos or sketches taken of the player or other family members during an SSC activity for publicity, advertising, promotional, and/or educational purposes including, but not limited to, news releases, publications, videos and publication to the World Wide Web as well as in joint promotions with SSC Marketing Partners. However, the aforementioned materials will not be used if the parent or adult player requests the Club do not use such items featured or shown in those materials.

Sandhurst Soccer Club (SSC) players agree to:

1. Represent SSC with values and principles of the highest standard both on and off the field.
2. Honor all commitments as required by the Club.
3. Treat all teammates, opponents, parents, officials, and coaches with courtesy, respect, and good sportsmanship
4. Participate exclusively with SSC for the entire soccer year or program.
5. Notify the Head Coach, Director of Coaching, d/or the Club Director if a member of another club's coaching staff or representative approaches them for purposes of recruitment.
6. Refrain from recruiting SSC players to transfer to another soccer organization.
7. Accept that the club reserves the right to move players between its teams.
8. Attend all Club training and games as required. Player understands that non-attendance without providing sufficient cause and notice may result in disciplinary action.
9. Commit to being on time for all team functions.
10. Commit to supporting SSC in activities that directly benefit the club.
11. Refrain from using foul language, alcohol, drugs, or nicotine or any other substance that degrades the player's athletic condition.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

Behavior by the parent or player in contravention to this Parent and Player Agreement and/or deemed inappropriate by the Club's Rules and Disciplinary Committee will result in disciplinary action which may include but is not limited to the following:

- 1) Letter of reprimand,
- 2) Probation with such special conditions as are deemed appropriate, and
- 3) Suspension for a definite period of time not to exceed one (1) year from the date of the offense.

Disciplinary action may be extended to include all family members depending on the situation or behavior that breaches the Parent and Player Agreement.

If the Executive Committee finds the conduct of any player/parent purposely ignores the Sandhurst Soccer Club Rules, Policies, and Procedures or is detrimental to the objectives of the Club, it may suspend the member, or take such other sanctions or actions deemed necessary under the circumstances.
