

Modifications to rules made for fall leagues are follows:

1) Hard Time Limit: Except in the playoffs, all games will be limited to one hour and fifteen minutes, and will finish once the batter at the plate at the moment time is called completes his at bat. For playoff games, normal summer time limit rules will be in effect such that any inning started within the time limit must be completed.

2) Pitcher Rule: Pitchers are limited to 1 inning per game or 3 OUTS...no rest period...no pitch counts. An inning is 3 outs. No penalty for a 4th out on a double or triple play. This rule remains in effect during the PLAYOFFS. (9/10 and 11-13 only)

3) Batter: All teams will Bat through the order each game including the playoffs.

4) Scoring: No official score except in playoffs.

5) Run Rule: Due to the strict time limits observed during the fall season, there will be a 5 run limit per half-inning in 9/10 and 11-13 games. As soon as the 5th run crosses the plate, the half-inning shall be over and no subsequent runs that cross the plate on the hit shall count, with the only exception being that all runs resulting from an "over the fence" home run shall be scored. This rule does NOT remain in effect during the playoffs.

6) Participation: As in summer a player may not sit on the bench 2 consecutive innings.
Teams will play 4 outfielders in the field.
