

Daily Procedures for Entering/Exiting Insports Centers and Participation

- Only staff, participants and coaches will be allowed to enter the facility during Phase 2 reopening. We will re-evaluate come Phase 3.
- Facility will be sanitized throughout each day and full disinfected each evening.
- All staff must wear appropriate PPE
 - o Masks at all times
 - o Gloves when cleaning or checking temperatures
- Staff, participants and coaches must complete daily health screen and **CLEARLY SIGN IN** to confirm that this was completed prior to entering the facility. Below are the requirements to pass the daily health and enter.
 - o Today or in the past 24 hours you have not had any 2 of the following symptoms:
 - Fever (temperature greater than 100.4 for children and greater than 100 for adults)
 - New or worsening cough
 - Shortness of breath or trouble breathing
 - New loss of smell and/or taste
 - o No member of your household has travelled to any place with a travel advisory within the past 14 days
 - o No member in your household has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days
 - o No member in your household has been in close contact with an individual who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- Must use designated entrance only doors when entering and adhere to all signage throughout the facility.
- Masks must be worn when entering the facility. Participants can remove once at field/court. Coaches must wear masks unless they can safely social distance (6 feet) from participants during play.
- Staff, participants, and coaches must sanitize their hand once entering the facility.
- No personal practice or game balls will be brought in by participants. Balls will be provided by Insports or coaches and will be sanitized prior to play.
- Participants must bring their own water bottles. Our water fountain will not be available for use until further notice.
- At the end of game/practice session, all balls will be placed in a designated bag/bin to be sanitized for next group.
- All staff, participants and coaches will be asked to sanitize their hands prior to exiting facility.
- Must use designated exit only doors when exiting.
- The facility will be entirely cleared out of participants and coaches before the next group can enter.
