Ridge Family,

I hope this email finds you in good health. Here's an update, as we near our resumption of play on August 1.

The Roadmap to Recovery for Nevada has not changed. The details are posted in the Return To Play Guidelines section on [MRL.org](http://MRL.org) and are quite stringent. Game play will be delayed until we have approval from the State of Nevada and the City of Las Vegas. This includes scrimmages against other teams.

Though game play has not been approved by the state, restricted and controlled practice sessions are allowed. Our current rostered teams will be permitted to practice in August after the Board purchase enough safety supplies for us to take the fields. The Board is in the process of procuring face coverings for players & all background checked volunteers, and hand sanitizer for use by each team.

Because we're in the Fall field allocation period, we do not have access to fields 5 & 6 until late September. This is not a problem for a traditional Fall season but the State of Nevada's mandated break period between practice sessions compounds our field access issues. The Board will be working on a new practice schedule that ensures we comply with the state's guidance. All participants (players, coaches, and volunteers) should be prepared for more administrative hurdles and less field time for league activities this season because of the restrictions.

The City of Las Vegas has issued an update, too. This email was sent to users, including league Presidents:

"Starting today the City of Las Vegas staff will be out at the parks monitoring the sports fields. In that, please ensure that your participants are abiding by the rules below and following all of the governor's directives outlined in the attachments.

- Participants must wear face coverings when entering and exiting the facility.
- Participants must wear face coverings on the bench. (Face mask are not required during play.)
- Participants must social distance while on the sidelines.
- User must provide at least a 10-15 minute transition time in between games.
- **Youth games are not allowed at this time.**

If these rules are not followed the city may fine or suspend any user group violating the governor's directives. Please follow all guidelines in order to help us keep the city of Las Vegas open and safe. Thank you for your continued use of City of Las Vegas fields."

Refund requests are being accepted until Sunday, July 26th. Refund information is available on the COVID-19 Refund tab at [mrl.org](http://mrl.org). The league will enter a non-processing period beginning on July 27th to begin making roster changes in preparation for the season resumption.
