Ridge Family,

I hope this message finds you in good health and in good spirits. It's been a pretty tough Spring for all of us at Mountain Ridge. Your incredible patience has been much appreciated while we're navigating through these unprecedented times. We've done the best we can to keep hope alive for our season. It is critical that our league's activities adhere to the guidelines set forth by the state and local government and health officials, in terms of public gatherings and sporting events when determining when it is safe to return to normal activities. Nothing is more important than the health and well being of our Ridge family.

After the message from Governor Sisolak on Friday, we remain in Phase 1 of the NV Roadmap to Recovery plan. The City of Las Vegas has not issued their "Return To Play" criteria, which we need to follow because Ridge gets our fields from the city. Based on this information, the Mountain Ridge Board of Directors has voted to suspend our season until Fall. This is extremely disappointing, because there is no better sound than hearing our players scream and yell, with the youthful joy, happiness and delight they bring to our fields.

Here is some exciting news I can share:

All is not lost. Because this is a suspension of play, we will be ready resume play this Fall. By moving to Fall, we can extend our season to complete a full season like we originally planned!

You will not need to complete a Fall registration, your Spring information will carry over. You are guaranteed a place for the Fall Season.

The teams that we put together this Spring, will transition directly to the Fall season. The connections we've already made, get to stay intact. Managers won't have to figure out how to get uniforms, eliminating a lot of the stress we go through each August.

Age charts stay the same for the Fall season. All players are still eligible to play in the division which they are currently allocated!

As this global pandemic was an unfortunate situation that is out of the control of our Board of Directors, we kindly ask those requesting a refund instead to consider continuing with us through the Fall season, or accept a credit for the Spring, 2021 season. This is to help us offset operational costs the league has already incurred prior to the pandemic. If you have a player aging out of the league and you have other children enrolled, you may use the refund credit towards their registration fees, also for the Spring, 2021 season. Any refund requests will be handled on a case by case basis. Any authorized refunds issued, will be less already incurred expenses. Please email refunds@mrl.org for refund questions.

Mountain Ridge will be able to host baseball clinics and "Sandlot" style games for players later this summer, once the state and local governments allow large gatherings and sporting events.

The District 4 Administration is committed to providing year end tournaments, either a Tournament of Champions or District All Stars. I have been a vocal proponent within the District, to ensure this will happen. Our players, who are aging out, still get this opportunity!

Most importantly, our players will once again get to play ball in the best Little League in Nevada; Mountain Ridge, home of the 2014 Little League United States Champions!
