Ridge family,

A lot has happened over the past seven or eight hours. Little League International and Nevada District 4 have recommended that all Little Leagues suspend play or postpone their seasons. Governor Sisolak has issued a Declaration of Emergency for Nevada. The NCAA, NHL & MLB have suspended or postponed play. CCSD has suspended all extra-curricular events, including sports.

Nothing is more important than the health and well-being of our children and the Ridge family. The Board of Directors has voted to suspend play until April 6, based on the recommendation from Little League International.

We know that takes us into our Spring Break. Honestly, we haven't had the time to discuss what that means to our players and our league. We do know that we cannot take the risk that one of our players or family members get exposed to the virus.

You may have questions, we do, too. Little League is reviewing how their recommendation will impact the season this year, including all star tournaments. District 4 is also revising options. When I find out more information, I will share it. Until then, there will be no sanctioned practices or games for the league.

The Board is ready to revisit this decision should circumstances change.
