



Tryout and Team Formation Update for the 2020/2021 Travel Soccer Season

Dear OSC/LCU Travel Soccer Family,

We hope this message finds everyone healthy and safe. As you are all aware, the COVID-19 Pandemic has created unprecedented circumstances that have altered every aspect of our spring soccer seasons. At this point, it has become clear that LCU will NOT be able to host tryouts in its traditional format. With this realization in mind, and like many other EPYSA Member Clubs, our OSC/LCU Travel Soccer Leadership Team has made the decision to proceed with team formation for the 2020/2021 Season without in-person tryouts. Because of this, **ALL LCU PLAYERS WHO ARE CURRENTLY ROSTERED ON A 2019/2020 TEAM WILL BE OFFERED AN OPPORTUNITY TO PLAY FOR LCU IN THE 2020/2021 SEASON.**

With this determination now in place, the following is some important information on how 2020/2021 team formation process:

- Your current Coach/Travel Administrators will start the formal team roster formation process via an invitation email. We expect emails to begin being sent out in the next few days.
- We kindly ask that players commit to the offered spot within the timeframe noted in the invitation.
- **We will not be collecting or withdrawing any travel soccer fees at this time.** Players who accept a position on a team will be prompted to complete an online registration form that will collect payment information for a future date.
- Once officially accepted, LCU will formally register each player with our national, state, and league governing bodies.
- If a player **DOES NOT** intend to return to the club for the 2020/2021 Season, please inform your coach of that decision.
- We will be working through all of our teams over the next week or two. Please allow time for the process to get started/completed.

LCU thanks everyone for their understanding as we work through these unfortunate changes to our normal evaluation and formation processes. We look forward to returning to play as soon as possible to begin our 2020/2021 season.
