Health and Safety Rules

- A face covering must be worn by all participants (players, coaches, and staff) and spectators at all times, including while actively participating, unless they meet an exemption listed by the PA Dept. of Health.
- Spectators should maintain physical distancing at all times.
- If you or anyone in your party has any signs/symptoms of COVID-19, leave the PASC fields immediately.
- A maximum of two spectators per participant is permitted.
- All members / attendees should thoroughly wash/disinfect their hands prior to and immediately after every training session or game.
- Bring your own hand sanitizer.
- No sharing of water or snacks.
- No shaking hands, high fives, fist bump, hugs, etc.
- Every player and coach must check his/her temperature at home and refrain from participation if he or she has a temperature above 100° or has any other symptoms of COVID-19.
- Players/Families who are determined to have had contact with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 will be required to self-quarantine until cleared for return by a member of the PASC COVID committee.
- All members are required to complete the PASC Health Report / Tracking form if they are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, have had contact with a COVID-19 positive individual or are under quarantine.
