COVID-19 Health and Safety Requirements 2021

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- **Stay home if you are sick or have been exposed to COVID-19**
- **Wear a face covering to protect you and your teammates, coaches and community:**

PRACTICES, GAMES AND SCRIMMAGES:

- **In order to ensure social distancing, practices will be limited to players and coaches only.**
- **Social distancing must be maintained at all times when off the field.**
- **Sharing of equipment will be strictly prohibited.**
- **No sharing of food, water or snacks.**
- **Handwashing and Sanitation.**

Modified Play

Given the limited risk for transmission by touch (i.e. bats/helmets) the league can mitigate the risk with vigilant wiping down of shared equipment in certain divisions (i.e. Tee Ball)

Provide 2 sets of full catchers gear (mask, chest protector and shin pads) for Jr, Sr, and Pony

- Additional investment likely for catcher's masks, shin guards, catcher's gloves, and disinfectant wipes
- Farm is aligned on pitching to net
