

What You Need to Know

- Games for children under age 12 are typically played at the fields behind the Pulaski Community Middle school. Due to issues related to the pandemic the school district is unable to formalize their schedule, so our timeline for this season is not final. Please check our website and look for emailed updates.
- Your child's coach will contact you by the first week in May with information about your child's team's first practice. If the season is delayed, you will receive an email with updated information.
- For U6 through U12 - Games will tentatively start after Memorial Day. For the 12-18 year old teams (BayLakes), games will start in June based upon field availability and when the WIAA spring sport season ends.

Important Dates

Last week in May - Target PYSC Season begins (ages 11 and under)

First Week of June - Target BayLakes Season begins (ages 12-18)

Saturday, July 24 - Saputo Tournament (U10 & U12)

Sat & Sun, July 31 & August 1 - Tony Litt Tournament (Ages 12-18)

No Jewelry or Hard Casts are allowed on the playing field.

- There are no exceptions to this rule! Covering jewelry with a scarf, Band Aid or hat is not allowed.
- If your child is wearing **any** jewelry he or she will be asked to remove it. If it cannot be removed, your child will not be allowed on the field.
- Hair accessories should be flexible. Avoid metal or rigid plastic.

Equipment - Players will need the following equipment:

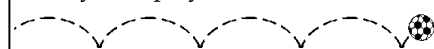
- Soccer shoes or tennis shoes, no baseball or football cleats.
- Shin guards - to be worn with socks that completely cover the shin guard.
- Their uniform t-shirt or jersey (as supplied by team).
- An age-appropriate soccer ball.
- A water bottle

What size soccer ball should I buy for my child?

4-7 yr old playersize 3 ball

8-11 yr old playersize 4 ball

12-18 yr old playersize 5 ball



WEATHER POLICY

Parents with children playing U12 and under, register for Pulaski Youth Soccer Club text or E-Mail Alerts to be notified of important club reminders and weather cancellations. BayLakes notification system uses a different process.

Otherwise, regardless of the weather, please show up at the field and expect a game. The field marshal or officials may cancel a game at the field if weather conditions change.

Soccer is played in the rain and in wet conditions. If a game is canceled it will not be made up. The full weather policy and a link to sign up for notifications is available at our Website.

Spectator Conduct

Please make watching the games a pleasurable experience for all.

For all U8 games and above, all spectators must watch games from behind the designated spectator line on the side opposite where the teams are located. Sometimes a parent may be asked to volunteer to help the coach on the side. All others should be on the other side.

Encourage the children. Cheer for both teams - "good job", "nice play"! Do not "coach" the children from the sidelines - this is the coach's job. Do not officiate from the sidelines

If a PYSC Field Marshal approaches you, please comply with the field marshal's directive. Field Marshals and other PYSC Board members have full authority on matters on the fields.

If you have issues or concerns with an official's call or a play, please raise them with your child's coach or an official field marshal *after* the game or contact the ref coordinator

At the end of a game, ask your child if they had fun.

You will need to read and sign the Parent Code of Conduct form at your child's first team meeting.

PYSC Play - 4 to 11 year olds

U06, U08 and U10 teams play other PYSC teams; we expect to play at the fields behind the Pulaski Community Middle School.

U12 teams may play a limited number of games against Howard-Suamico U12 teams. Most U12 games will be played in Pulaski. Away games against H-S teams will be played in Howard-Suamico area fields.

PYSC's U10 & U12 leagues' tournament will be held on Aug 5th at PYSC fields at PCMS.

Referee! Referees must be 12 years old or older by Memorial Day. Parents can referee too.

Training is required for both new and returning referees. Various training sessions for referees will be available through BayLakes this spring. Check the PYSC web site for more details and specific dates. Training fees will be reimbursed.

You will need a yellow referee shirt and shorts, a stop watch and a whistle. Referees under 18 years old will also need a work permit. To get your permit you will need to present your social security card and a letter of intent, to the Pulaski High School office. A letter of intent and application is available on the referee page of our website.

What else should I know?

Do not bring your pet. No Pets are allowed on school property. Do not bring your pets to games. It does not matter if the pet is on a leash or is being carried, it is not allowed.



Pets are also not allowed on any field where BayLakes games are played.

Fencing, goal posts and other fixed equipment are not playground equipment. You are responsible to make certain that your children do not climb on or hang from the goals.

No smoking or consumption of alcohol is allowed at events on school grounds.

Parking - During the school year, please park in the lot on West Glenbrook St. Use the pedestrian bridge to gain access to the fields. When wet the bridge may be slippery (particularly for players in soccer shoes).

After school is out for the year, you can use the parking lots at the Middle School or continue to park on Glenbrook.

BayLakes Play - 12 to 18 year olds

Play for 12-18 year olds is determined by BayLakes, the governing body for the Green Bay area. Typically two games per team per week are scheduled. Games are held evenings on Monday through Thursday.

Home games for the U15 and U19 leagues (both Boys and Girls) will be played at Four-Seasons Park in Hobart. Away games are held in the greater Green Bay area. Players are responsible for their own transportation.

For qualifying teams, the Bay Lake's annual "Tony Litt" Tournament in De Pere.

COACHES NEEDED!

Consider coaching your child's team. No experience or knowledge of soccer needed. PYSC will provide training and equipment.

Coaching involves a commitment of just one hour a night, two nights a week.

Requests for friends or family members to be on the same team will not be honored. The only exceptions are for co-coaches' children and siblings of the same sex/age group.

PYSC Training is offered at no cost to you, is held in Pulaski and all training is tailored to the age group you are coaching. Other training options are available. Details are available at the website.
