



2021 Denver Winter Invitational Game Day Protocols
Updated February 15, 2021

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL TEAM PERSONNEL AND FAMILY MEMBERS ASSOCIATED WITH YOUR TEAM UNDERSTAND THE GAMEDAY PROTOCOLS LISTED BELOW. We will have a zero tolerance and your team could be subject to dismissal from the tournament and no refund given if your team and/or anyone associated with your team (i.e. parents, spectators, family members, etc.) is found in violation of these protocols. We are all in this together with the #1 goal of having the kids play and we thank you in advance for making sure everyone associated with your team is aware of these protocols.

As of February 6, 2021 – Jefferson County is operating in Level Yellow Restrictions and this includes Long Lake Ranch in Arvada and Rooney Road in Golden. Listed below are specific protocols per field complex. Please make sure you and your team understand the protocols in place for each specific complex.

GAME DAY PROTOCOLS - Long Lake Ranch, Arvada

- Symptomatic athletes and spectators should isolate and contact a healthcare professional to discuss the need for evaluation and testing. Athletes and spectators attending the tournament that test positive for COVID-19 must notify the tournament immediately and follow instructions from the local public health agencies.
- Due to current restrictions on the number of people (players, coaches, spectators, referees, etc.) allowed in an area of the complex, game fields will be spaced out accordingly to maintain proper distancing between all parties involved.
- **For ALL Games, maximum 2 spectators are allowed per player participating.**
- When spectators, players and coaches are coming and going to the fields, they **MUST** wear a face mask.
- **Spectators MUST remain in their vehicle until kickoff time.** Please do not come out to the field prior to kickoff.

- When watching the game, spectators must maintain social distancing from other households. Spectators within the same household may sit together within 6 feet of each other. Spectators must sit at least 15 feet away from the field of play and/or any game participants.
- While standing and/or walking around the fields/complex, all participants and spectators must wear a face mask.
- **Teams are asked to arrive to warm up no more than 25 minutes before play** and not enter the field area until the previous teams have completely vacated the space. Teams need to vacate the field / complex at the conclusion of their game as soon as possible. Please do not congregate on the fields after the game.
- The home team will occupy the North or West side of the field, while the away team will occupy the South or East side of the field depending on the field layout. **All players, coaches and spectators from the team will occupy their respective side of the field.**
- Players must wear a mask while not actively participating in the game, including being on the sideline as a substitute. **Coaches MUST wear a mask at all times.**
- **Players and referees are exempt from wearing a face covering while exercising or engaging in sports activity outdoors** where the face covering would impair their ability to engage in activity.
- **Team benches are not allowed.** Players and coaches need to bring their own chair if needed.

GAME DAY PROTOCOLS - Rooney Road, Golden

- Symptomatic athletes and spectators should isolate and contact a healthcare professional to discuss the need for evaluation and testing. Athletes and spectators attending the tournament that test positive for COVID-19 must notify the tournament immediately and follow instructions from the local public health agencies.
- Due to current restrictions on the number of people (players, coaches, spectators, referees, etc.) allowed in an area of the complex, game fields will be spaced out accordingly to maintain proper distancing between all parties involved.
- For ALL Games, maximum 2 spectators are allowed per player participating.
- **ALL SPECTATORS MUST REMAIN OUTSIDE THE FENCE / IN THE PARKING LOT AREA. Only game participants - players, coaches, referees, athletic trainers, tournament staff, etc. will be allowed on the playing field areas beyond the fences.**
- When spectators, players and coaches are coming and going to the fields, they **MUST** wear a face mask.
- **Spectators MUST remain in their vehicle until kickoff time.**
- When watching the game, spectators must remain behind the fences and maintain social distancing from other households. Spectators within the same household may sit together within 6 feet of each other.
- While standing and/or walking around the fields/complex/parking area, all participants and spectators must wear a face mask.

- **Teams are asked to arrive to warm up no more than 25 minutes before play** and not enter the field area until the previous teams have completely vacated the space. Teams need to vacate the field / complex at the conclusion of their game as soon as possible. Please do not congregate on the fields after the game.
- The home team will occupy the North or West side of the field, while the away team will occupy the South or East side of the field depending on the field layout. **All players and coaches from the team will occupy their respective side of the field.**
- Players must wear a mask while not actively participating in the game, including being on the sideline as a substitute. **Coaches MUST wear a mask at all times.**
- **Players and referees are exempt from wearing a face covering while exercising or engaging in sports activity outdoors** where the face covering would impair their ability to engage in activity.
- **Team benches are not allowed.** Players and coaches need to bring their own chair if needed.
