



Prospective Lake Murray Little League Manager/Coach:

Managing or coaching in Little League is one way you can give back to the community and make a lasting impact on young people. While it is natural to want to get on the field and coach as soon as possible, it is critical that you understand what will be asked of you.

Whether you are new to the league or a returning volunteer, here are the necessary steps to be considered for a managing or coaching position:

- **Complete all necessary volunteer paperwork in its entirety.** This includes giving your social security number for a Little League background check.
- **Complete the Center for Disease Control Heads Up Concussion training for coaches.** This required training is brief and free. Complete the training and forward the certificate to coach-coordinator@lakemurrayll.org
- **Attend a preseason interview.** If you want to manage or coach, this is necessary to instruct the players.
- **Sign our Lake Murray Little League Coach code of Conduct.** Please submit this paper at your interview.

Once selected as a manager or coach:

- **Complete a district approved safety course***
- **Complete a district approved coaches clinic***
- **Participate in assessments for CAPS, Minors and Majors.** We require you stay for at least one other division's assessment to assist.
- **Attend draft to select your team.**
- **Attend a field maintenance day.** Volunteering as a manager or coach requires you to provide basic field care before and after all home games. You will be instructed on how to set-up and tear down a field on game day. This is fundamental to providing for a safe practice and playing environment.
- **Attend coaches meeting**
- **Managers and coaches will be expected to umpire games at all levels when not using association umpires.**

* District 33 mandates these two courses be completed every third year, but at least one coach on a team's staff is currently trained in this season's calendar year.
