- 1) Roster shall consist of no less than 11 and no more than 13 players. There will be a continuous batting order. **Bunting is allowed; if batter attempts to swing the bat after showing a bunt the batter is automatically out.** Stealing is allowed. A runner may attempt to steal a base when the ball has crossed the plate after being pitched or at any time that the pitcher does not have his foot on the rubber.
- 2) Eight year olds may be rostered in the nine year old division. No ten year olds are allowed on the nine year old roster.
- 3) Only players, one manager and two coaches may occupy the dugout during the game. **No jewelry worn by players, managers or coaches.** Medical alert tags are accepted. **Sunglasses are permitted on the field, however only prescribed sunglasses may be worn by the pitcher.**
- 4) Home will provide scorekeeper. An official pitch counter will be assigned to game.
- 5) All equipment must meet Little League standards.
- 6) All catchers must wear protective helmet with throat guard, chest protector and shin guards. Male players must wear a cup.
- 7) Games will be 6 innings or one and a half hours provided 4 innings are played. 15 run rule will apply after 3 complete innings. 10 run rule will apply after 4 complete innings. In case of a tie: will go one extra inning. If after this inning we still have a tie, winner will be decided via coin toss.
- 8) Each inning will be determined by 3 outs or 5 runs, whichever comes first.
- 9) Pitching:
  - ↵ 1-20 pitches thrown: 0 calendar days rest is required.
  - ↵ 21-35 pitches thrown: 1 calendar days rest is required.
  - ↵ 36-50 pitches thrown: 2 calendar days rest is required.
  - ↵ 51-65 pitches thrown: 3 calendar days rest is required. (9 year olds)
  - ↵ 50 pitches thrown: **Maximum pitches thrown per day** (8 year olds)
  - ↵ 75 pitches thrown: **Maximum pitches thrown per day** (9 year olds)
  - ↵ **A pitcher that delivers more than 41 pitches in a day cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.**
  - ↵ Any player, who has played the position of catcher in 4 or more innings in a game, is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day. (If he catches one pitch in the 4<sup>th</sup> inning. that constitutes the 4<sup>th</sup> inning).
  - ↵ If a pitch reaches a day(s) of rest threshold, while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs without penalty.
    - E.g. the pitch count will stop until the batter has terminated his or her time at bat. (LL rule

- 10) Each team will provide one box of balls. Little League approved RS or RS-T only.
- 11) No arguing with umpires or tournament officials will be tolerated.
- 12) No profanity, unsportsmanlike conduct, tobacco of any kind or alcohol will be allowed.
- 13) Coin toss at least one hour prior to game with tournament official or umpire.
- 14) Birth certificates and medical releases should be carried with team in case you are asked for them.
- 15) Managers are responsible for making sure dugout is cleaned out after each game.
- 16) Managers, coaches and players will dress as befits Little League rules.
- 17) No on-deck batter. No soft toss or batting sticks permitted on field. No warm-up outside of fields due to safety reasons.
- 18) Managers or coaches are not permitted to warm-up any players before or during game.
- 19) Runners must stay in contact with base until ball is hit.
- 20) There will be mandatory play with a minimum of 3 consecutive outs.
- 21) Infield fly ball will be in effect.
- 22) Championship game will be 6 innings - no time limit. Will play extra innings to break tie to determine winner.
- 23) Bats must meet USA Baseball bat standard. (USABAT)
- 24) Upon 1<sup>st</sup> offense of a rule violation, manager will be warned and given the chance to correct. Failure to correct or repeated violations will result in a manager being removed for the remainder of the game and the following game. If a manager is removed, no substitutions will be allowed.
