MACHINE PITCH

All players must be in the hitting lineup and all players must play in the field for all 3 innings or play time, whichever comes first.

All players bat in each inning. The last batter rounds all the bases and the inning changes. Each batter will get 5 pitches and if by the 5th pitch does not hit the ball, the batter is out and returns to the bench.

When 3 defensive outs have been made, the bases will be cleared and the outs start over at 0, and so on until all the offensive players have hit.

Games will last 3 innings or 1 hr. 15 min. max. If 3 innings are complete and time still remains teams may play one more inning, but still cannot exceed the 1 hr. 15 min. time limit.

Home team of the early game puts out bases. Visiting team of the last game picks up the bases and puts them back in the storage shed on their field.

Coaches must use pitching machine at all times.

ALL INJURY REPORTS MUST BE FILLED OUT ASAP FOLLOWING AN INJURY AND TURNED IN TO THE OFFICER ON DUTY.
