



**RANCHO BUENA VISTA LITTLE LEAGUE
COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL AGREEMENT**

On behalf of myself and my son, daughter, or person for whom I serve as legal guardian, I understand that Rancho Buena Vista Little League requires the following safety protocols that have been developed by the league utilizing guidelines provided by the County of San Diego, State of California, Little League International, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in response to the current spread of SARS-CoV-2 that causes COVID-19.

Agreement to the protocols set forth below is required to participate in Rancho Buena Vista Little League as of June 22, 2020. We require one signed agreement per player.

1. All field time will be assigned by Rancho Buena Vista Little League. Teams may only use assigned fields during their scheduled field time and may not hold any other team activities on our outside of our facility unless approved in advance by the league.
2. Practices are limited to a maximum stable group of 12 players or less per field, all of whom must be rostered on the same team, and a maximum of 1 manager plus 2 coaches. No extra players, siblings, or pool players can practice with a team to which they are not assigned at any time. There is to be no co-mingling of players from different teams.
3. No games will be held until groups of players larger than 12 are permitted to gather by local guidelines. Intra-squad scrimmages by stable groups of 12 players will be allowed.
4. Except under special circumstances, no parents, grandparents, siblings, spectators, fans, or other people besides the team's rostered players and coaches may be in attendance at any practice.
5. Carpools are not permitted other than by members of the same family living in the same household. All players must arrive by parent or guardian.
6. All players and coaches will have their temperatures checked prior to entering the facility. Any player or coach with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will be required to leave immediately.
7. All players will be required to wash hands with soap and water prior to the start of practice. In order to facilitate more hand-washing traffic, both of our restrooms will be unisex. The restroom closest to the snack bar entrance is designated for players on the Majors field and the other restroom will be for everyone else. No more than one person in a restroom at a time.
8. All players and coaches are hereby instructed to stay home if they have any symptoms of illness including, but not limited to, fever, cough, sore throat, sneezing, body aches, loss of sense of smell or taste, difficulty breathing, or fatigue. Any player or coach who tests positive

for COVID-19 cannot return until at least 14 days have passed since the test was conducted and has a written note from a physician that the player or coach is no longer infected.

9. There will be no sharing of equipment. Players must bring their own bat, glove, helmet, batting gloves, or any other equipment. The sole exception to this rule is catcher's gear, which, if shared, must be thoroughly disinfected by a coach between uses.

10. Players are permitted, but not required, to wear face coverings during practice. We strongly suggest that players wear face coverings when arriving at and leaving the facility. Each family will be allowed to make its own policy for their child(ren) with respect to face coverings and will notify the manager in advance of the first practice as to what that policy will be.

11. Managers, coaches, and any other adults are required by the County of San Diego to wear face coverings at all times and maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from one another while at the facility.

12. No food should be brought to practice and there will be no sharing of water bottles. Please make sure that your player brings plenty of water as the water fountain will be disabled and the snack bar will be closed.

13. Hand sanitizer will be provided by the league and players will be expected to take water and sanitizing breaks every 20 - 30 minutes during practice.

14. Whenever practical, players will be kept 6 feet apart. Closer proximity or even physical contact between players that occurs during the normal course of drills or simulated gameplay is allowed.

15. Until further notice, no one is allowed in the dugouts.

16. Players are not permitted to gather around batting cages or bullpens. There shall be a maximum of one player per lane in the batting cages and one player waiting by each of the batting cage doors. All other players should be waiting elsewhere, at least 6 feet apart from one another. Only two players at a time (one pitcher, one catcher) may utilize the bullpen.

17. Activity or gatherings of any kind before or after practice or "extra" practice time are prohibited. There is no loitering at the field before or after practice. The team manager should arrive early to assure that all protocols are followed and should not leave until all players have been picked up.

I acknowledge that I have read and understand these protocols and I agree that I will strictly comply with them at all times. I understand that any failure to comply will result in a loss of ability to participate in activities with Rancho Buena Vista Little League.
