# Required Duties of a Head Coach in the Slidell Bantam Baseball Association

1. Practice the team at least two hours but not more than a maximum of eight hours per week. No practices may be held on Sundays.
2. Ensure that all coaches, team mothers, scorekeepers, players and their families conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner during all Games.
3. Be present and/or make sure your team is represented at all required Work Parties.
4. Teach the game of baseball/softball according to sanctioned rules and regulations, and as amended by the rules of SBBA.
5. Stress sportsmanship, learning skills, and participation.
6. Appoint a Team Mother and Scorekeeper(s).
7. Umpiring is required.
8. Be responsible for team's equipment and return it to designated official as soon as season is completed.
9. Do not solicit money for recreation league parties or trophies.
10. Work with SBBA Officials, Team Mother, and player's parents in performing all necessary and required functions.
11. Be willing to abide by the decisions League Commissioners and/or the SBBA Board of Directors.
